Flowers on the Altar are in memory of Louis & Clarrisa Epping placed by Cynthia Johnson.

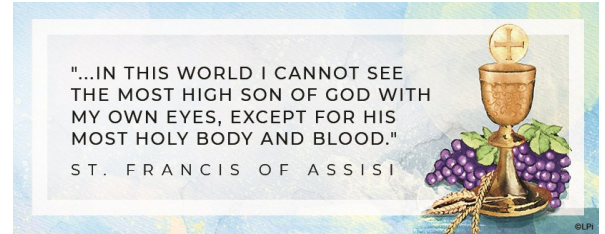

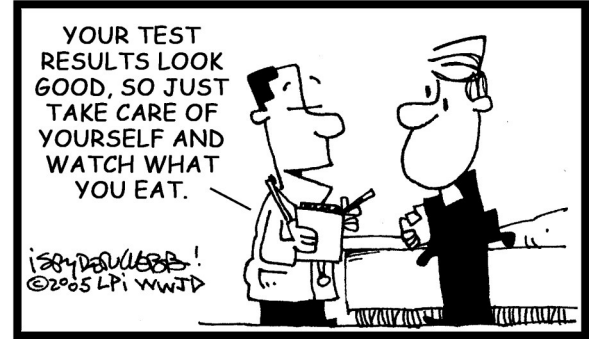

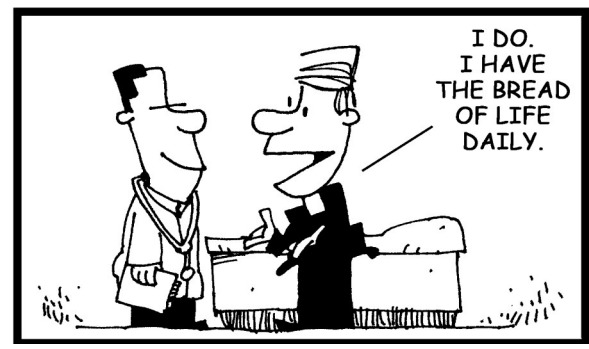
