Friendly reminder to please silence/turn off phones before Mass starts and also enter and leave Church quietly and respectfully!

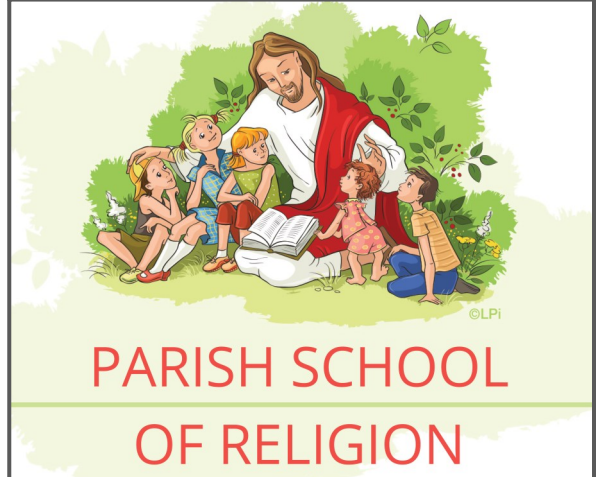
