**Congratulations** to Steve & Jean Elliott on celebrating their 50th Wedding Anniversary.

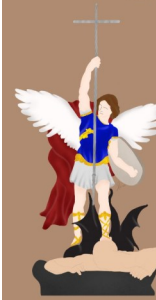
