#### **Sun Safety Reminder**

With the hot weather predicted to continue, it is important to ensure that our pupils are safe whilst enjoying the sunshine. Please continue to help us by taking the following precautions:

- **Sunhats/Caps:** Ensure your child wears a sunhat or cap to school every day to protect their face and head from direct sunlight.
- **Sun Cream:** Apply sun cream to your child in the morning before they arrive at school. This will provide them with the initial protection they need.
- **Labelled Sun Cream:** Please send a labelled bottle of sun cream with your child's name on it. This will allow your child to reapply sun cream during break times. We will be encouraging your child to apply the sun cream themselves, so please support your child with this, especially the younger children.
- **Water Bottles:** Ensure your child has water bottles that they can refill at school throughout the day. This is vital to ensure that the children are kept well hydrated throughout the day, where they are free to refill their water bottle at school.
