Parent Consultations – Booking Reminder



Punctuality - The Importance of Being on Time

When children arrive late, they miss vital early morning work that consolidates their learning and prepares them for the lessons ahead. Arriving late also means missing the start of the lesson, which can leave children unsure of what to do. The school day begins at **8.45am** and arriving promptly ensures that your child does not miss key learning time and prevents disruption to teachers and other pupils. Persistent lateness can lead to significant loss of learning time, which can impact on your child's overall progress and attainment. We monitor lateness daily and will be in touch with parents if your child is persistently late to school.

Impact of Lateness

Being 15 minutes later each day is the same as missing 2 weeks of school



Houses and PE Shirts Update
