Head's Update

A Busy Week of Professional Development

This week has been focused on strengthening our teaching practice through trust-wide training and collaboration. We started with our regular check-in with Kate Lund, our hub director, on Tuesday. On Wednesday morning, I attended our Headteacher hub day, whilst Mrs Davies joined me at the EYFS Forum in the afternoon. Thursday saw both myself and Mr Hopkinson at the Maths Forum, and we concluded the week with the English Forum, where English leads and headteachers from across the trust shared best practice. These collaborative sessions ensure we are continually improving our practice and that our pupils benefit from the very best approaches being used across our trust schools.

Uniform Efforts – Thank You

Bikeability Level 1 - Year 3/4

We ended the week with Pine Class taking part in their Level 1 Bikeability sessions today. Level 1 is an exciting gateway to starting your child's cycling adventure to get them ready for on road cycling. The session today, took place on our playground, where the children learnt to navigate their bikes in a traffic-free environment.

Bikeability Level 1 teaches the children to:

- **Maintain your cycle:** make sure your ride is in tip-top condition and make simple repairs.
- **Glide:** smooth, calm and collected.
- **Control your bike:** including setting off, cruising, slowing down, braking and stopping. Even learning to pedal one handed.
- **Pedal:** without feeling wobbly or out of control.
- **Be aware of your surroundings:** looking behind and turning around obstacles.

It would be great if your child could practice the skills they have learnt over the weekend and beyond with your support.

Trust-Wide Assessment Week

Next week is our trust-wide assessment week. These assessments are an important part of monitoring your child's progress throughout the year. We will discuss the progress your child has made at our parent consultations after half term. Please ensure your child is in school and arrives on time each day, as assessments will run promptly throughout the week.
