Curriculum Swimming Lessons and Water Safety

We were delighted to have our swimming pool open at the start of this week, as part of our PE curriculum pupils will participate in swimming lessons throughout this term. These lessons are an important opportunity for pupils to develop essential water safety skills and confidence in the water. In addition to this, we invited Ian Roberts, Lead Adviser for PE, who delivered our staff training on Swimming, to do Water Safety sessions with our children that took place this morning.

Our PTFA have also organised after school swim sessions and it is fantastic to see so many taking part. These sessions offer a chance for children to enjoy swimming in a relaxed and supervised environment, and we are incredibly grateful to the PTFA for their hard work in organising and supervising these events. This is a great opportunity to not only have some enjoyment in the pool, but to start building water confidence from an early age.

Hub Day on SEND Provision

This week, I attended a SEND hub day organised by our hub director, Kate Lund at one of our hub schools. The focus was on revisiting our Trust expectations and sharing good practice by working collaboratively to strengthen our support for children with additional needs. These opportunities help us to learn from each other, ensuring we continue to offer high-quality, inclusive education for every pupil at Guilden.
