Joe Solinsky, Chair called the meeting to order at 6:03PM

Tim made a motion to accept the January 29, 2026 Select Board Meeting Minutes. Joe seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Tim made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report for February 26, 2026 as printed. Joe seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Delinquent Tax report handed out.

Robert & Diane Hill: Regarding the roof on their house. Almost 4 years ago, they entered into an agreement with Rural Edge for funds to fix their roof. Rural Edge provided various roofers that required insurance. Rural Edge had the Hill's sign a contract stating they would not get any law enforcement agencies involved should any issues arise. When the roofers arrived they in fact had altercations with each other. Rural Edge is not willing to have their roof fixed from damage caused by the roofers they contracted with, at Rural's suggesting they hire. The roofers also had no insurance, which was a requirement from Rural Edge. The board suggested contacting Marty Feltus for possible suggestions on steps to be taken.

Martin Quatt: Talking about the tires at the end of Underpass Road. He has safety concerns at that intersection with the tires encroaching onto Underpass Road and Route 5. The board has spoken with the person to no avail. Patti said the Sheriff's Department will deliver a certified letter from the town stating he has 30 days to remove the tires or be fined \$25.00 a day. The select board members will talk to Logan from the state to see if he has some ideas. Vermont state agencies will not return any calls to the board members. Martin said he may have some ideas to possibly get some agencies involved.

Denis made a motion to amend the purchasing policy to reflect what the State/Fema is requesting be added. Tim seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Highway Foreman, Shane Heath updated that everything is going well. We received a couple of loads of salt to help us through the winter. The sand is getting down but Shane said he is careful using it, so we will not run out.

The Patoine property needs to be addressed with being fixed the board recommended they utilize Fiddlehead Bridge and not Patoine Bridge when carrying materials to repair the field the town used until Fiddlehead Bridge was replaced.

Suggestion from a resident about visibility at the corner of Calendar Brook Road and Burke Road. Shane said he will be removing the snow at that intersection to avoid any visibility issues. .

The board feels they are prepared for Town Meeting. Joe's term is up and he will be running again.
