Landscape

A **painting or drawing of a large area of the natural world**, for example mountains or fields

Seascape

A type of landscape painting which is of **the sea**

Method

A **way of doing something**, for example the steps for painting a picture

Sketch

A **rough drawing or painting**, possibly to be looked at to be able to complete a finished drawing or painting

Brushstroke

The **mark made by a paintbrush**

Symmetry/ symmetrical

Where the parts of a picture or object **look exactly the same on both sides**, a mirror image

Natural materials

**Things from nature**, used to make art, for example leaves, sticks or stones

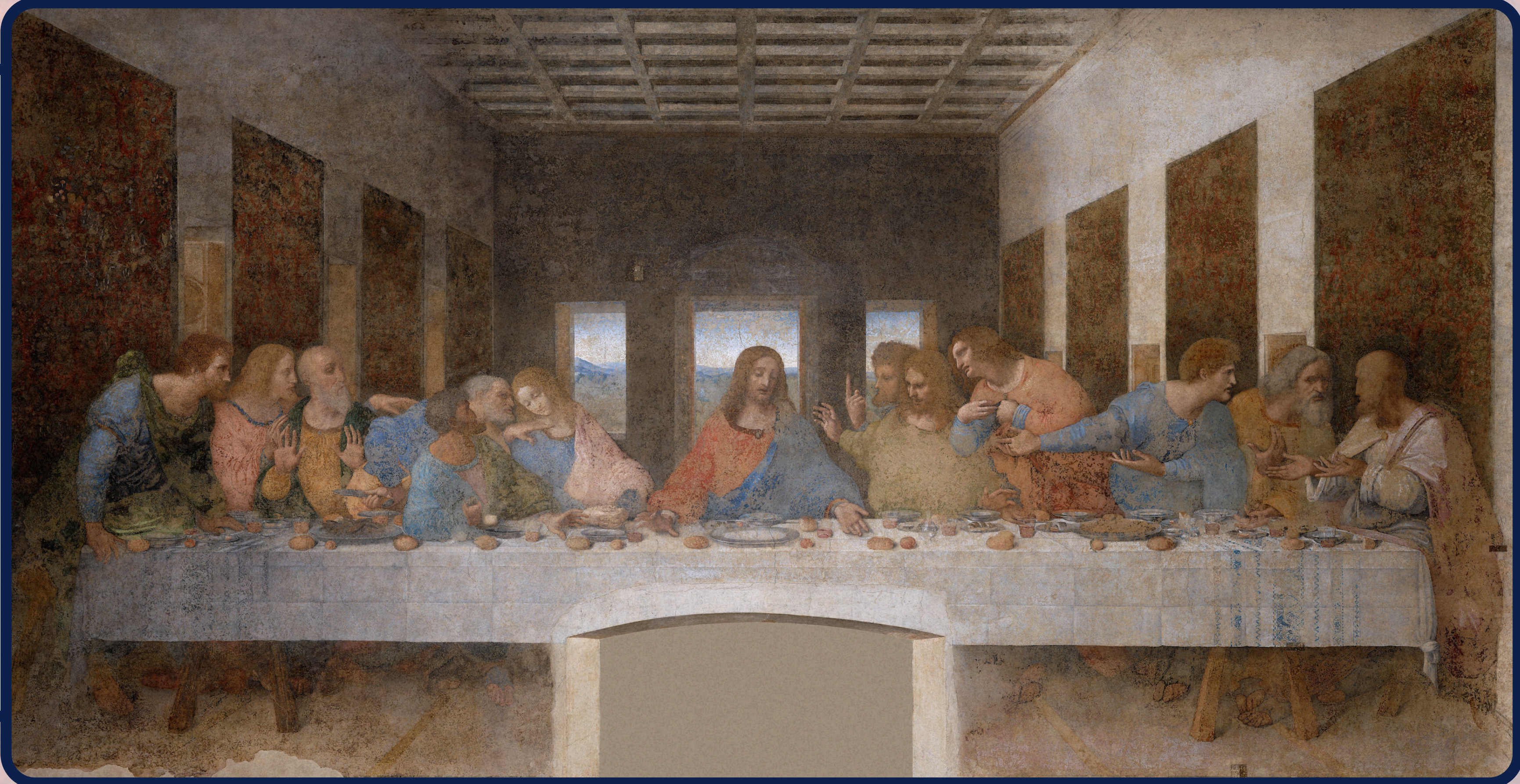
Temporary
