

## Take One Picture

### Year 5

This unit of work uses the National Gallery's *Take One Picture* scheme for looking in depth at one piece of artwork. The approach to the picture is intended to be investigative and as such the planning for this unit is a general guide and acts as a framework resource for how a unit of work, with six individual lessons could be used as an approach to the chosen picture. Through the process of studying the picture it is intended that the children use it as inspiration for a finished artwork following an analytical process of investigation, sketching and planning, leading to production of a finished piece, working individually or with their peers.

Works the children have produced can be entered for a competition to gain entry in a yearly exhibition focussed on the picture. The planning in this unit focusses on the approach which the gallery look for when selecting works for the exhibition: using a child-led investigative approach; making meaningful cross-curricular links, giving pupils an opportunity to learn a new process and making links with the wider community.
