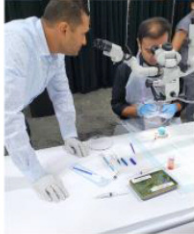

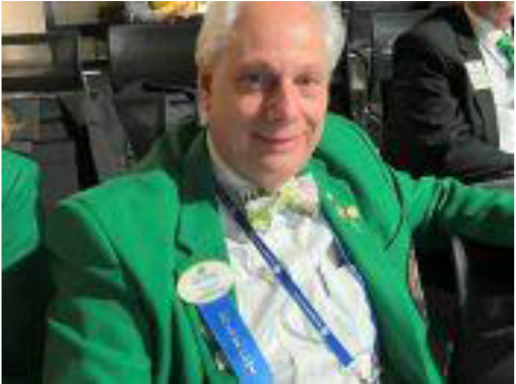

- *Arrange time before the meeting for Gov. to meet each club member
- *International requires the Governor to meet with the BOD, usually arranged for after the meeting.
- *Invite your Region and Zone Chairs, spouses are welcome.
- *As a courtesy to the office, members should stand and applaud when Governor is first introduced.
- *Notify the Governor if you have new members you want inducted or awards you want presented.
- *If the meeting is a spouses night, notify the Governor
- *Have local media coverage if possible.
- *Seat the District Governor at the head table.
- *Spouses always sit on the guest's right, but no lady should be seated at the end of the table or left of the podium unless a Lioness or Officer is a woman.

INTRODUCTIONS:

- *Individual recognition of all Lions dignitaries should be made only once, and that should be done by the presider of the occasion. Other speakers addressing the audience should recognize the Head Table as follows: Presiding Officer (ie: Dist Gov), other Lion Dignitaries, Ladies and guests. (repetitious recognition of each Lion dignitary by each speaker has long been considered needless and boring. Your use of this procedure will be appreciated by all as an improvement.
