Coffins made from En√iroboard on page 2 are a stronger alternative to cardboard for those wishing to reflect their ecological values.

A light oak veneered coffin with routered 'penshaw' panel sides and ends with a raised lid, brass coloured bar handles and nameplate.



The Ascot - £715

A veneered mahogany coffin with routered 'penshaw' panel sides and ends with a raised lid, brass coloured bar handles and nameplate.

A cardboard coffin interior structure with a woven willow surround and lid.



Tributes Teardrop Willow - £764

Hand woven willow coffin. The teardrop shape provides a softer appearance than traditional angular edges.

The Oakham - £950

A solid oak coffin, hand made with double moulding to the base and butt-jointed ends.



The Tamworth - £960

A solid sapele coffin with double moulding to the base and lid.



The Argyle - £1000

A solid mahogany coffin with square panel sides and raised lid.



The Barnard - £1050

A solid oak coffin traditionally made with butt joints, panelled sides, ends and raised lid.
