

## STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£3166.00</b>
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£1400.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£375.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's: [branch premises]	£200.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from Cardboard	£390.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£1.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£800.00
<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
<b>Burial (funeral director's charges only)</b>	<b>£1780.00</b>
<b>Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)<sup>2</sup></b>	<b>£2300.00</b>
<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b> . <sup>1</sup>	<b>£719.00 - £777.00</b>

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.



# Additional Options Price list (bespoke funeral options)



All funeral directors are legally required to publish the Standardised Price List for a standardised set of products and services, to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors. We understand that the 'Standardised Price List' may not include options best suited to the types of funeral services people may want to arrange, in this case we can offer more bespoke options which are listed below.

We are legally obliged to list a charge for all services the CMA has listed on the Standard Price List, however if a bespoke funeral is chosen the services listed below will be included at no extra cost:

1. Embalming/hygienic treatment of the deceased person (unless risk of infectious disease is present).
2. Visiting the deceased person in our chapel of rest (within usual working hours)<sup>3</sup>
3. Collection of ashes from the crematorium, storage in our office for up to three months, delivery to an address within 5 miles of our office.

In addition to these complementary services, if a bespoke option is chosen, some reductions can be made if certain services aren't required, such as an £80.00 reduction if we collect the deceased person from an address within 15 miles of our office within usual working hours (defined as Monday – Friday 9:00 – 17:00).
