Appointed Festivals

23 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ² "Speak to the Israelites and say to them: These are the appointed festivals of the LORD that you shall proclaim as holy convocations, my appointed festivals.

³ "Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of complete rest, a holy convocation; you shall do no work: it is a Sabbath to the LORD throughout your settlements.

⁴ "These are the appointed festivals of the LORD, the holy convocations, that you shall celebrate at the time appointed for them. ⁵ In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month, at twilight, there shall be a Passover offering to the LORD, ⁶ and on the fifteenth day of the same month is the Festival of Unleavened Bread to the LORD; seven days you shall eat unleavened bread. ⁷ On the first day you shall have a holy convocation; you shall not work at your occupations. ⁸ For seven days you shall present the LORD's offerings by fire; on the seventh day there shall be a holy convocation: you shall not work at your occupations."

⁹ The LORD spoke to Moses, ¹⁰ "Speak to the Israelites and say to them: When you enter the land that I am giving you and you reap its harvest, you shall bring the sheaf

of the first fruits of your harvest to the priest. ¹¹ He shall raise the sheaf before the LORD, that you may find acceptance; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall raise it. ¹² On the day when you raise the sheaf, you shall offer a lamb a year old, without blemish, as a burnt offering to the LORD.

¹⁴ You shall eat no bread or parched grain or fresh ears until that very day, until you have brought the offering of your God. This is a statute forever throughout your generations in all your settlements.
