Bring **3–4 dozen brownies**, pre-cut into 1" squares for tasting. Please provide an ingredient list for allergy safety. Cups will be provided to put your small squares into.

Be creative—fun names for your chili or brownies are encouraged! Everyone attending gets to taste and vote in the "People's Choice" categories.

Not a Chili or Brownie fan? No problem! We will also be serving shredded Chicken Sandwiches, Salad, Fruit, Mac & Cheese and more. So, everyone can enjoy the feast and Fellowship.

Rally Day Food Drive: Along with the fun, Rally Day is a time to reach out in service. This year our Mission Project is a "Food Drive for AGAPE Ministries", and we're making it a little competitive! LUKE 14:16-24

¹⁶ Then Jesus said to him, "Someone gave a great dinner and invited many. ¹⁷ At the time for the dinner he sent his slave to say to those who had been invited, 'Come, for everything is ready now.' 18 But they all alike began to make excuses. The first said to him, 'I have bought a piece of land, and I must go out and see it; please accept my regrets.' 19 Another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going to try them out; please accept my regrets.' 20 Another said, 'I have just been married, and therefore I cannot come.' 21 So the slave returned and reported this to his master.
