Maple Leaf ...

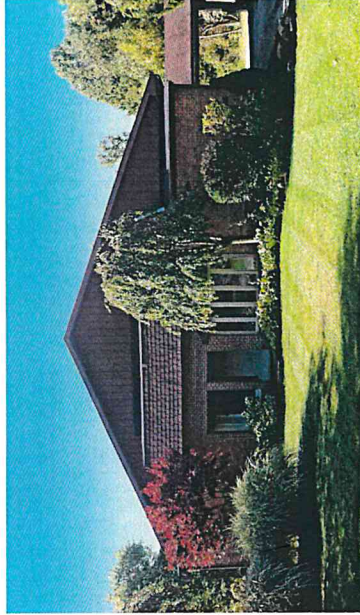
- ◆ Has over 85 residents living in our 25 homes throughout Geauga County.

Our Story

Maple Leaf Community Residences was founded in 1989 by a group of parents of children with Developmental Disabilities. They recognized the unmet needs of those in the county with developmental disabilities who needed safe housing and special care. Some have loyal family members or friends and others are without any support or a stable safe place to live.

Led by Joan Butler in co-operation with Metzenbaum, our founders went to work to change all that and the rest is history. Today, Maple Leaf owns 25 houses providing care to 85 people who depend on our services daily.

Many are still on the waiting list of the GCBDD (Geauga County Board of Developmental Disabilities) to move into a home like Maple Leaf offers. Our commitment is to help them off the list and into one of our houses. With daily supervised care, they can live in a home they can call their own.

Any of our residents will tell you that they enjoy their feeling of independence. They are not living in mom and dad's home, not a nursing home and certainly not an institution. They are proud to be responsible, as much as they are able, to clean their own space, cook their own meals, wash their clothes, and yes even pay their own bills.

At Maple Leaf, our Staff, Trustees and many Volunteers have made a serious personal commitment of heart to help those who cannot help themselves.
