Dr. Aquil Basheer

Founder and Executive Director BUILD (Brotherhood United for Independent Leadership Through Discipline)

Dr. Aquil Basheer is the founder of BUILD and a global expert in violence intervention, public safety, and gang prevention. He also founded the License to Operate Movement and teaches as an adjunct professor at Alliant International University. He has trained elite safety teams worldwide and advised the World Health Organization and United Nations on violence prevention. His book, Peace in the Hood, is a leading guide on community-based intervention. Dr. Basheer has earned numerous honors, including the California Peace Prize and a Doctorate of Letters in Humanities.



Aqeela Sherrills

Founder and Executive Director The Reverence Project

Aqeela Sherrills grew up in the Jordan Downs projects of Watts and was once involved with the Grape Street Crips. After a life-changing moment in college, he committed to healing from his past and helping others do the same. At 19, he co-founded the Amer-I-Can Program with NFL legend Jim Brown and helped broker the historic 1992 peace treaty between the Bloods and Crips. After losing his son Terrell to gun violence, Aqeela founded The Reverence Project, creating wellness centers in urban war zones to support healing through restorative practices, art, and dialogue. His vision of "beholding" invites us to see possibility even in pain. Today, he is a global voice in peacemaking, trauma healing, and justice transformation.



Captain Robert Hawkins

Robert Hawkins is a Fire Captain with the Los Angeles City Fire Department and President of the Los Angeles Stentorians, championing diversity and inclusion in the fire service. With over 24 years of experience, he's a trailblazer known for breaking barriers and leading with purpose. A graduate of the LAFD's West Point Leadership Academy and Cornell's DEI certificate program, Robert also contributed globally through the Zambia Z7 Project, training firefighters and donating a fire engine. Currently pursuing a degree in Emergency Management, he is deeply committed to building a fire service that is as diverse and dynamic as the communities it serves.
