What are Minimum Professional and Additional Professional Services?

MINIMUM SERVICES

The minimum professional services represent the minimum non-declinable services required to facilitate the disposition of a deceased person whether by cremation, burial or aquamation. These minimum professional service charges are applicable to every family we service and include transferring the deceased from the place of death (nursing home, hospital, private residence, coroner's office, airport) to our facility where we will hold the deceased and then place them into a casket or container of your choosing and is securely held until the necessary documentation is completed (death registration/coroner's certificate for cremation or aquamation). Transportation of the deceased in a minimum service vehicle to the cemetery/crematory or aquamation facility at the earliest practicable opportunity, or scheduled time, as applicable.

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE MINIMUM PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CHARGE:

- *Any supplies, such as casket/container/shroud, burial vault, urn, stationery, jewellery etc.
- *Any additional services that may be selected such as embalming, visitation/gathering and any type of ceremony which include a funeral/memorial/ graveside service or celebration of life.
- *Additional mileage fees beyond 50km.
- *Applicable HST

MINIMUM REQUIRED DISBURSEMENTS WHICH ARE NON-NEGOTIABLE:

- *Disbursements to be paid to third parties on your behalf which could include; crematory or aquamation fee, coroner's, death registration.
- *Cemetery fees are required to be paid directly to the cemetery

WHAT ARE ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL SERVICES?

Additional professional services offered by Jardine Funeral Home include options that would be required in order to conduct further ceremonies for the deceased. These additional charges include embalming, staff services for a gathering or visitation, staff services for a ceremony such as a funeral service, memorial or celebration of life, a graveside or reception, and our facilities to host such ceremonies and services.

- *Any supplies, such as casket, container, burial vault, urn, stationery, jewellery etc.
- *Any additional services beyond those specified
- *Additional mileage fees beyond 50km
- *Applicable HST
- *Disbursements to be paid to third parties on your behalf which could include; crematory fee, coroner's, death registration, newspaper, flowers, catering.
- *Cemetery fees are required to be paid directly to the cemetery

ADDITIONAL DISBURSEMENTS OPTIONS:

Flame Cremation Fee

Charged by the crematory for the cremation of the deceased. Jardine Funeral Home retains the services of Riverside Cemetery and Crematorium located in Lindsay. If it is the purchasers choice, if they should want to use a different crematory. Additional mileage will apply over 40km.

The Bereavement of Ontario Consumer Protection Fee

The fee is charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) in order to provide the consumer information of the options within the bereavement sector and to regulate the profession making sure the law is consistently followed.

Coroner's Fee

This is a Provincially set fee charged by the Coroner for issuing a certificate that approves the cremation or aquamation process or 'out of province' shipping.

Interment Fee

The fees charged by cemeteries for opening and closing a grave vary between cemeteries. Your funeral director can provide you with an estimate and contact information for the fee to be paid directly.

Death Registration Fee

This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a 'disposition' permit, then forwards the registered documents to the Office of the Registrar in Thunder Bay.

Clergy Honorarium

This fee is paid directly to the ordained minister or pastor for their services to organize and conduct the ceremony.

WHAT ARE DISBURSEMENTS?

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf. Jardine Funeral Home Ltd., will act as an agent to obtain third party providers. Any prices quoted in this section are subject to change without notices. Third party providers can change their prices at any time during the year and we are contractually obligated to charge you accordingly. Such items included but are not limited to:

Organist

This fee is paid directly to the organist or pianist for playing at the ceremony.

Church Fees

This fee is paid directly to the church if they have facility rental fees. Varies

Custodian Fee

This fee is paid directly to the church custodian in order to prepare the church for the ceremony and the post clean up and disinfection.

Audio-Visual Fee

This fee is paid directly to the church, if applicable, in order to broadcast any digital media or music.

Varies

Death Notices

This fee is paid directly to the newspaper that is requested. We have the ability to insert the death notice in any paper that is requested. The fee charged by the newspaper is the fee that will appear on your final invoice.

Varies

Flowers

If desired, you can ask your Funeral Director to arrange for floral tributes such as a casket spray, urn wreath, sprays etc. Your funeral director can provide you with an estimated cost. The fee charged by the florist is the fee that will appear on your final invoice.

Monument Inscription

If the need requires, you can ask your Funeral Director to arrange to have the monument inscribed with the final date of death.

There are many options for setting aside funds to cover your funeral costs. Pre-arranging your funeral today means that the cost associated with your funeral arrangements are guaranteed and locked in for future need. WHAT ARE THE FUNDING OPTIONS I CAN CHOOSE FROM:

WHAT IS INSURANCE?

Funeral Insurance offered by Funeral Plans Canada and Equitable Life of Canada provides you with the coverage you need for your final arrangements combined with the payment flexibility and group annuity coverage to meet every situation and every budget. Credit card payments are accepted on single payment plans and monthly time payment plans of three years or longer. The plan is fully transferable should you chose to relocate. Talk to Monica or Rob to discuss which plan is best suited for you.

WHAT IS THE GUARANTEED TRAVEL ASSURANCE PLANS?

Are you planning to travel? If you die while travelling, transporting your body back home from across the country or abroad can be a costly endeavor. Enrolling into Guaranteed Travel Assurance Plan (GTAP) covers the costs and logistics of repatriation back to your home. Simply pay a one-time fee of \$495 (HST included) and you will be covered for life. This plan covers expenses when a death occurs anywhere over 100km from your home and for those who like to travel, provides you with tremendous peace of mind.

THE DEATH OF A LOVED ONE

At some point, every family has to face the reality that life ends. Sometimes it is the result of an illness, or after a long life, but sometimes it happens suddenly, with no time to prepare.

HEARING THE NEWS

When a death occurs, the immediate family has the task of letting other family members and friends know what has happened. This is often when the fact that a loved one has died begins to sink in.

FAMILY GATHERS

Special Music

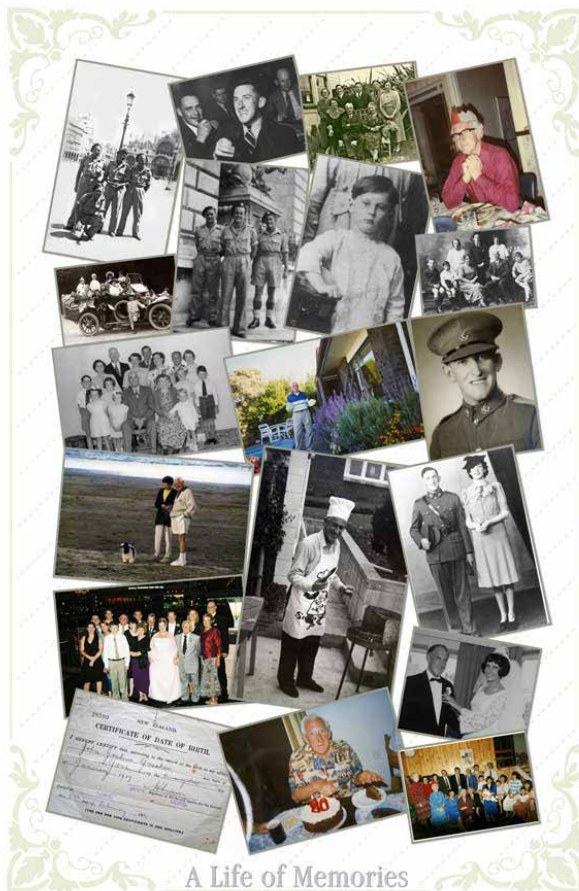

Arranging for consultation with a licensed funeral director, coordinating all aspects of arrangements such as: contacting clergy, cemetery, newspapers for funeral notices, arranging for transfer of the deceased and staff for transfer, arranging for flowers, reception, extra vehicles, receiving and processing all donations, setting up flowers and delivering, if required after the funeral. Arranging for staff on the day(s) as well as required vehicles. We provide a minimum of four staff members at every ceremony with the exception of a graveside where only two staff members are required. We arrange for custodians, organists/soloists, receptions, parking facilities and reserved seating. We are pleased to provide a Book of Memories portal on our funeral home website www.jardinefuneralhome.com. For families choosing immediate cremation our Basic Professional Service charge is reduced.

Documentation ^(M)

\$495

Completion and filing of all documents to carry out the services and supplies requested included but not limited to the Service Ontario Form 15 Statement of Death, Notification of Death for CPP/OAS, City of Kawartha Lakes Death Registration and subsequent disposition permit used for burial/cremation or aquamation, cemetery consent or cremation/aquamation application, Service Ontario Portal for Cremation/Aquamation consent via the Coroner. Our documentation fee also includes 12 Funeral Director Statement of Death issued by Jardine Funeral Home Ltd. and are commonly known as

"Death Certificates" which are able to be used in most Estate settlements. Also included in our documentation fees are the perpetual care of our records for future generations as well as the ongoing and maintenance of our website.

Basic Preparation of the Deceased ^(M)

\$203

Requires the facilities for preparation, embalming and shelter. Disinfection and dressing of the body and placement into the casket or container selected prior to burial, cremation or identification or viewing without embalming.

Embalming of Remains (Optional)

\$490

Requires basic preparation of remains. Embalming is the disinfection, preservation and restoration of the body by replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. Embalming is a suggested service should a family wish an open casket with either public or private family viewing. Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the remains between time of death and the services arranged for, or in certain circumstances, depending on the cause of death. Written permission is required by the executor or informant of person responsible for the funeral expenses prior to the embalming being performed. Jardine Funeral Home Ltd. requires the body must be embalmed if the body is to be in the funeral home's possession for more than 48 hours or at the discretion of the licensed funeral director.

Transfer of Remains ^(M)

\$350

Transportation of the deceased from their place of death by professional staff (residence, hospital, nursing home) to the funeral home within 50 km., and requires the use of our service vehicle. Additional fees apply beyond 50 km at \$2.40 per kilometer and is charged only one way.

Staff Services

\$499

Staff to assist the licensed funeral director(s) with the gathering or informal get together for a period determined by the package selected.

In Funeral Home Staff Services for the Ceremony/Setup

\$195-\$499

Staff to assist the licensed funeral director(s) with the transition from gathering to ceremony. This includes and not limited to assistance with family, pallbearers or public seating, moving of floral or picture displays as well distributing bulletins, leaflets or hymn books.

Facilities for Preparation, Embalming and Shelter ^(M)

\$525

Use of the preparation room equipment, chemicals and sundries, maintenance supplies, hazardous waste disposal, specialized equipment, sanitation of preparation room, compliance with all government standards and temporary shelter and storage of remains up to 48 hours.

Weekend and Statutory Holiday Surcharge

\$285

This fee applies to all visitation, gatherings, ceremonies, receptions on or off site as well as interments that occur on a Saturday, Sunday or Statutory holiday.

Facilities for Gathering \$525

The use of the funeral home for a gathering period of up to four hours to include allowances for the payment of taxes, insurance, utilities, advertising, promotions and general maintenance, coffee lounge supplies, parking lot maintenance and expenses (snow removal/grass cutting), telephone, sound system, and other specialized systems as required.

Facilities for On-Site Ceremony \$525

For a ceremony taking place in our facility, this fee includes allowances for payment of taxes, insurance, utilities, advertising, promotions, general maintenance, snow removal, landscaping, technology, and other specialized systems as required.

Off-Site Ceremony Events \$775

For a ceremony taking place outside of our facility, this fee includes allowances for off-site events such as preparing items (sound system, flowers, family memento's, etc.) for transportation, travel time, permits, location set up and tear down, that may be located at a church, cemetery, community hall, backyard events etc.

Facilities for Reception \$200

Use of Reception facilities following the Funeral Service or Ceremony for family and guests to attend and socialize.

Staff Services for Reception \$36/hour

A minimum of 2 staff are required to host the post funeral reception in our facility or at the venue of your choosing. \$36.00 per hour with a minimum of 2 hours.

Minimum Identification \$249

A funeral director will accompany no more than 2 persons to make the identification and authorize Jardine Funeral Home to proceed with arrangements. 20 minute maximum

Funeral Coach \$550

Primarily used to transport the casket, container or urn to the place of ceremony, cemetery or crematorium.

Service Vehicle \$375

Available for use 24 hours/day and is primarily used for the transport of remains from the place of death to our facility. It is also used to deliver floral arrangements following the ceremony or memorial to the family home, place of reception or location to be determined by the family. Additional fees apply beyond 50 km at \$2.40 per kilometer and is charged only one way

Graveside Tent Rental \$500

The provision of a 10x10 tent for an outside event, such as a graveside ceremony or celebration with no vault purchase.

Funeral Celebrant \$350

As a professional service of Jardine Funeral Home, we are able to connect you with a "Insight Certified Funeral Celebrant". A Funeral Celebrant is a person who is trained to provide personalized and individualized celebrations to reflect the personality and lifestyle of the deceased. The Celebrant will consult with the family and funeral home in order to provide a meaningful ceremony which can include favourite music, opportunities for other friends and family to speak openly, while focusing on a broader sense of spiritually and not religion.

Grass & Device for Grave Set Up \$625

The cemetery graveside artificial grass and the device we use to lower the casket in the ground is supplied by a third party. These items are used when no burial vault is required or purchased.

Audio Visual Surcharge \$200

If a family chooses to create their own stand alone Slide Show presentation that has not been created by Jardine Funeral Home this fee applies for the use of our equipment.

Aftercare *Complimentary

The executor role is a challenging one. There are 100+ steps and most executors are grieving the loss thus making the job even more difficult. We will assist in applying for benefits under CPP and Survivors, notify SIN, OHIP, Equifax, CRA, Trans Union Credit, Drivers Licence and much more. *This service has a value of \$300 that will be applicable if the Online Super Saver service is selected.

Are you thinking of Flame Cremation?

We would be honoured to assist you in arranging for cremation. We wish to share some information about cremation with you.

THE FLAME CREMATION PROCESS

Flame cremation involves reducing the body to bone fragments by applying intense heat for a period of two to three hours. The cremated remains, which are commonly referred to as ashes, are removed from the cremation chamber, and any metal objects are removed. The cremated remains are then processed, so that they are of an equal consistency. They will often appear white or grey in colour, and typically weigh between 1 to 2 kilograms.

What mementos or personal items can be placed in a casket prior to flame cremation?

Some personal items can be placed in the casket, like notes or photos, which can be a helpful way to say goodbye. Since most items will be destroyed as part of the flame cremation process, we suggest that jewellery be removed and placed inside the urn with the cremated remains after the cremation has taken place.

What funeral services can be selected if flame cremation is chosen?

Flame cremation does not limit the funeral services that may be chosen. The same options available with earth burial are available with cremation. Some of these choices include the type of casket, having an open casket viewing or visitation, location of service, and type of funeral or memorial service. Ask one of us if you have any questions about this.

ATTENDING THE CREMATION

We are used to being present for the burial of a loved one, but have you considered attending the cremation? Some families find it beneficial to accompany us to the crematorium, and to have a goodbye ceremony in the crematorium chapel, as a way of seeing the process through. If desired, you may even witness the beginning of the cremation process in a respectful manner. Many families have appreciated accompanying their loved one for a final journey. Ask your funeral director about how this might work for your family.

Cremation containers differ from caskets in their function as they are not intended for the long term care of the deceased, but serve their function during the funeral ceremony only. As a result there are a number of modest cremation containers available to be used when the services are of a private or brief nature and serve mostly to transport and carry the deceased for cremation.

When a gathering and a funeral service are part of the arrangement, many families appreciate the option of a rental casket. These caskets are identical in appearance to the burial caskets, yet they function differently. Only the interior shell and bedding of the rental casket is purchased and accompanies the deceased throughout the funeral right to cremation. The exterior shell of the casket serves as ornamentation and is only rented for the period of the funeral. This introduces some practical cost savings and reduces wood combustion in the cremation process.

Are you thinking of Traditional Burial?

SOME FACTS ABOUT TRADITIONAL BURIAL

The body is buried in a casket, and the casket may be placed in a concrete liner or a vault. The body can be buried shortly after death, after a visitation and/or funeral service, or before a memorial service. The body may be buried in the ground or entombed (must be embalmed) in a mausoleum.

Embalming is not required for traditional burial, but may be recommended, depending on the gathering and funeral arrangements.

DO I NEED TO PURCHASE A VAULT?

Some cemeteries either require or recommend purchasing a vault or cemetery liner to enclose the casket in the ground. This offers protection from the weight of the earth, and in the case of sealing vaults, protection from the elements in the ground.

PLANNING AHEAD

We believe it is a good idea to select burial plots ahead of the time of need if possible. Selecting a final resting place for a loved one is an important decision that we can help you with. We have information available for all cemeteries in the area and can provide you with comparisons so that you can make a decision that fits both your wishes and your budget. Please give us a call or send us an email if you would like any information about cemeteries in our area. In addition, we can help you with designing and installing a fitting tribute with a memorial monument or marker.

WHAT MEMENTOS OR PERSONAL ITEMS CAN BE PLACED IN A CASKET PRIOR TO A TRADITIONAL BURIAL?

Any personal items can be placed in the casket, like notes or photos, which can be a helpful way to say goodbye. We will ask you whether any jewellery or mementos placed with your loved one during the visitation should be left with the person, or returned to the family. If desired, we can donate eyeglasses to charity.

ARE KEEPSAKES FOR CREMATION ONLY?

Some people find it helpful to have a part of their loved one to keep with them, as a special way to remember them. This is possible if you choose traditional burial as well as flame cremation. Instead of cremated remains, a lock of hair can be enclosed for safekeeping, or a special note or photo. We have jewellery options that can incorporate your loved one's fingerprint or lockets that will hold an important photo. Ask one of us to tell you about the many options available.

WHAT IS GREEN BURIAL?

Green Burial is a statement of personal values for those who seek to minimize their impact on the local and global environment. For people who are mindful of the cyclical nature of life, green burial is a spiritually fulfilling alternative to conventional burial and cremation. It is an environmentally sensitive practice; the body is returned to the earth to decompose naturally and contribute to new life.

THE FIVE PRINCIPLES OF GREEN BURIAL?

No embalming - Decomposition is nature's way of recycling the body. Human Remains can still be prepared for private family viewing.

Direct Earth Burial - Human Remains are to be wrapped in a shroud that is biodegradable and if desired the shrouded remains can be placed into a casket, container or wicker which are made of sustainable and fully biodegradable.

Ecological Restoration & Conservation - After allowing some time for grave settling, using the guidelines set out by the burial site indigenous plant materials, groundcover, shrubs or trees will be planted in order to enhance the delicate ecosystem.

Communal Memorialization - Individual memorials are discouraged. Green Burial sites are a living memorial to the person interred there.

Optimize Land Use - Optimization of land use which exclude the installation of infrastructure such as roads as an example.

Green Burial Arrangement Options:

For those wishing a simplistic green burial this option includes our basic professional fee, documentation, transportation from place of death, temporary facility for shelter, basic preparation of the deceased, and transportation to the green burial cemetery plus additional mileage outside of our 50km radius. 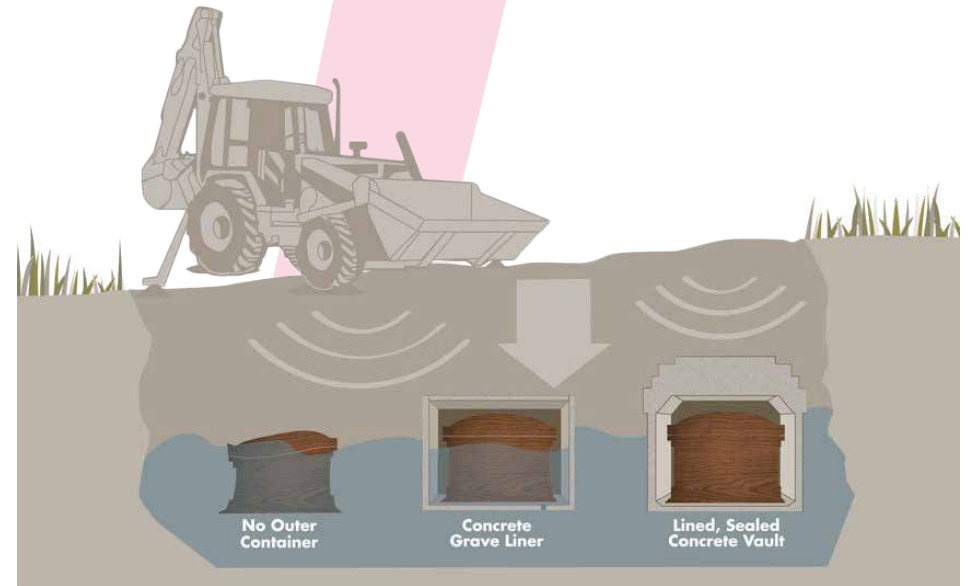
