The **Diocese of Orlando Memorial Garden Cemetery Rules and Regulations** are adhered to by the **Ascension Memorial Garden Ministry**. They oversee the management and perpetuity of the area. Keeping our garden beautiful, quiet and peaceful is a meaningful way to express our love for those interred in the garden.

- A maximum of two bouquets of flowers (Fresh cut or silk) are permitted following the first two (2) weeks after interment. Fresh cut flowers are encouraged. Dead wilted or faded flowers will be removed.
- Plants, shrubs, trees, or flowers are not permitted to be placed or planted by anyone other than the Cemetery Authority.
- Grave borders marked by any materials are not permitted.
- Articles and or containers made of fragile or breakable materials will be removed.
- A flag, not to exceed 24" in height, may be placed temporarily on a grave one week before Memorial Day, Veterans Day and Independence Day. Flags must be removed three (3) days after the holiday.
- Adornments such as balloons, toys, statues, photos, battery or solar operated lights and printed materials are not permitted.
