On behalf of Consejo's leadership team, I extend heartfelt gratitude to our employees, interns, community volunteers, independent contractors, and clients for their contributions to our success. It is with pride that we present our 2024 Annual Report, a reflection of a year marked by growth, resilience, and innovation.

In 2024, Consejo expanded its impact across nine counties, partnering with 34 school districts to provide school-based behavioral health care and launching the Consejo on Wheels Behavioral Health Mobile Clinic, bringing bilingual, culturally sensitive care to rural communities.



We also introduced bi-directional medical services, integrating behavioral and physical health care to address chronic conditions, systemic inequities, and the needs of survivors.

Our dedication to workforce development continues as we partnered with 44 colleges nationwide, training the next generation of behavioral health professionals to ensure equitable, culturally responsive care.

A Consejo Client's Journey to Recovery: Skagit County Therapeutic Community Court



After facing a DUI and legal challenges in 2023, a client turned to Consejo for support. With guidance and perseverance, she rebuilt family bonds, embraced sobriety, earned her GED, and enrolled in college. In January 2024, she invited her therapist to her graduation from Skagit County Therapeutic Community Court, saying, "This was a team effort." Her journey is a testament to resilience, support, and new beginnings.

School-Based Services: How Therapy Transformed a Sultan School District Student's Success

A student with conduct disorder faced severe emotional outbursts, leading to classroom lockdowns and the risk of expulsion. Through therapy, she developed self-regulation skills, learned to communicate openly, and now expresses frustration calmly while seeking support from her teacher and mother. When a friend drew in her favorite book, she remained calm, processed it in therapy, and handled the situation without an outburst. Once a high-priority client, she now attends therapy every other week, steadily growing into a confident and capable young woman.


