What is SEFP?

SEFP is a licensed residential program for pregnant and recently post-partum woman. The program works with residents to build a stable and healthy lifestyle, provides recovery support services, parent education and counseling, and planning for a post-SEFP life.

Who can come to SEFP?

SEFP is open to pregnant and recently postpartum Virginia resident who are at least 18 years of age and has a primary diagnosis of substance use disorder.

Can I enroll immediately?

Bed availability fluctuates on a daily basis. Please contact us to discuss availability.

If you are in need of emergency mental health treatment, please call 911, go to the nearest emergency room or call H-NNCSB's Emergency Services at (757) 788-0011.

How much does it cost?

The program may be covered by your health insurance plan. We can assist with assessing or determining eligibility.

What are some of the services offered at SEFP?

- Education on relapse prevention skills
- Substance use disorder and cooccurring mental health education (group and individual)
- Treatment services based upon assessed clinical need
- Gender specific treatment addressing the unique needs of women with substance related disorders
- After care planning, community support, and linkage to needed resources
- Linkage to medication assisted treatment services

How long can I reside at SEFP?

The program is designed to serve the residents based on individual need in a person-centered treatment environment, which encourages stabilization.
