What is an Opioid Treatment Program?

Our opioid treatment program is a an outpatient substance use accredited treatment program licensed to provide methadone medication; counseling and other psychosocial rehabilitation services for addiction to opioid drugs.

Can I enroll immediately?

Appointments for intake are scheduled at the time of the initial telephone screening. The program's goal is to schedule the intake appointment to include medication, within 72 hours. Priority is given to pregnant women.

How do I make an appointment for enrollment?

To make an appointment call (757) 240-5223 or walk-in during business hours for a screening and appointment.

Benefits of Opioid Treatment

- Safe and proven to be effective
- Cost-effective
- Reduce the risk of over-dose and death
- Reduce drug cravings
- Improve social functioning i.e. work, school etc.
- Increase treatment retention
- Reduce the risk of infectious disease transmission
- Reduce the risk of returning to use.

Program Eligibility:

Adults with a primary misuse and physical dependency on opioids such as prescription pain medications, heroin and morphine, fentanyl etc.; a developed tolerance to opioids; onset of withdrawal symptoms following a short period of nonuse of opioids.

How much does the treatment cost?

The cost of opioid treatment is determined by income and may be covered by your insurance plan or grant funding.

What should I bring to the enrollment appointment?

- **Photo identification**
- **Proof of address**
- **Insurance card**
- **Proof of Income (last 2 paystubs, W-2, Social security eligibility letter)**
