TOPIC	MODIFIED RULES FOR THE FUTURE LEGENDS U10 DIVISION
LENGTH OF GAME	Two 25-minute Halves with 5 minute half.
PLAYERS	6v6 Five field players and a Goalkeeper for each team. Recommended formation: Goalkeeper, 2 Defenders, 1 Midfielder and 2 Forwards (2-1-2) All restarts (throw-ins and free kicks) on the offensive side of the field should be taken by the defenders. There are Goalkeepers in the U9/ U10 Divisions.
FOULS	Both yellow and red cards may be issued by referee Penalty kicks are awarded by referee
SET PLAYS	Yes, Corner kicks Yes, Goal kicks Yes, Throw-ins
GOAL KICKS	Being encouraged to play out of the back, goal kicks can be played vertically without encroachment until the second touch.
BUILD OUT LINE	The build out line promotes playing the ball out of the back in a less pressured setting When the goalkeeper has the ball in his or her hands during play from the opponent, the opposing team must move behind the build out line until the ball is put into play. Once the opposing team is behind the build out line, the goalkeeper can pass, throw or roll the ball into play (punts and drop kicks are not allowed). After the ball is put into play by the goalkeeper, the opposing team can cross the build out line and play resumes as normal. The opposing team must also move behind the build out line during a goal kick until the ball is put into play. Play must resume play within 6 seconds of the defensive team moving back behind the Build out line.
OTHER	All players play a minimum of 50% . Player's time is connected to practice and participation, if a player regularly misses practice, it will affect playtime. NO punting by Goalkeeper On all re-starts from the Goalkeeper, the defensive team must start behind the build-out line or top of the penalty area. players if necessary. Goal differential: Differentials of 3-4 goals, teams should start getting creative by limit touches, ten passes before shooting, shoot outside of the box only, moving players positions or playing a player or two down to challenge the winning team. NO results are being recorded, NO league standings, or win/loss/tie records. Please do NOT relate success of your team to how many games they win. Coaches may come on field during restarts for positioning, but must exit field before play resumes.
SAFETY	All items of jewelry (necklaces, rings, bracelets, watches, earrings, leather bands, rubber bands, large hair bows etc.) are strictly forbidden and must be removed. Using tape to cover jewelry is not acceptable.
