Accessibility / Site Description

Morgans Butchery is accessed from outside via ramp, with hand rails either side or by 3 steps with hand rails either. There is a traditional butchers chain fly guard on the door but please speak with staff and they will move this out of the way if needed. There is also access via ramp through the shop next door 'The Pantry' here there is only a hand rail on one side, again there is a chain fly guard on this doorway. The flooring inside Morgans is flat and smooth but turning space is limited due to the size of the store. There is a portable card machine, with braille overlay available. There is lightly gravelled surfaces around the store.

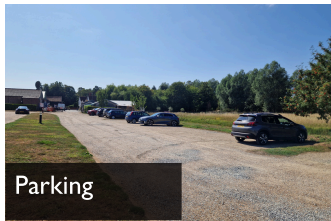

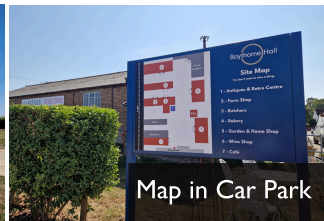

Disabled Parking




Disabled parking is available on site; our team is happy to help if you need support finding it.

Accessibility / Site Description

Accessible parking is available on site, but it is not immediately visible from the main entrance. After passing the main gravel car park, continue onto the hard concrete surface and go through the wooden gates. Follow the route past the café, where you will find an area with disabled parking signs displayed on the wall.

The surface in this area is lightly gravelled. There are currently no painted or marked parking bays, but the space is intended for disabled parking and is generally flat and level. If you need any assistance when arriving, our team at Morgans Butchery will be happy to help.

Bicycle parking for up to three bikes is available in the courtyard opposite the butchery; please bring your own lock.

Accessibility / Site Description

Bicycle parking is available in the open courtyard area opposite Morgans Butchery. The bike rack is attached to a raised planter and has space for up to three bicycles. It is located near a flower bed, with a small black sign with white writing marking the area.

The surface in the courtyard is level and open, making it easy to access. Please note that no bike locks are provided, so you will need to bring your own lock if you wish to secure your bicycle.


Accessibility / Site Description

Sensory Experience

-  Corridor with windows in hall way, enclosed toilet cubicles
-  Chemicals used for cleaning, air freshers with varying scents
-  Noise from cafe next door, noise from hand driers

Toilets

Toilets are located in the toilet block outside the café and include an accessible toilet with handrails and baby changing facilities.

Accessibility / Site Description

There is one toilet block on site located just outside the café. To enter the toilet block there is a small raised threshold at the doorway. The accessible toilet is the first door on the right when you enter. The door opens inwards. Inside the accessible toilet there are both fixed and movable handrails beside the toilet. There is also an emergency pull cord for assistance. A baby changing table is mounted on the wall to the left. A hand dryer and a small electric radiator heater are also located on the left-hand side as you enter. A small hand basin is located on the right-hand side. There is a large bin next to the toilet. Cleaning chemicals may also be stored within the toilet facilities. Separate men's and women's toilets are also available within the same toilet block.
