Discussion

1. Have you ever struggled to believe something that turned out to be true? What made it hard to trust at first?
2. What resonated with you from Sunday's worship?

Read John 20:19-31

3. What stands out to you most?
4. How did Jesus respond to the disciples' fear and Thomas's doubt? What does that reveal about His character?
5. What does John say is the purpose of his Gospel (v.31)? Why is that important?
6. What does it mean that we are "blessed" even though we have not seen Jesus physically?

Read 2 Peter 1:12.

7. Where in your life do you need to be reminded to believe?
8. Where are you experiencing "locked doors" (fear, anxiety, uncertainty) in your life right now?
9. What questions or doubts are you carrying, and how can you bring them honestly to Jesus this week?
10. What is one step of trust Jesus may be inviting you to take to move from knowing about Him to truly believing in Him?

Next Steps

- **Love Jesus:** Journal about where you are experiencing "locked doors."
- **Connect with Others:** Share a question or struggle with a trusted believer and invite them to walk with you toward deeper faith.
- **Serve the World:** Volunteer with the Rummage Sale, trusting Jesus will use your efforts for His glory.
- **Reach the Lost:** Pray for one person who is searching or skeptical and look for an opportunity to share why you believe the Good News of Jesus Christ.
