Dear Parents,

Next year, it will cost approximately \$8,200 to educate each child at Annunciation Catholic School. With generous support from our parish, our tuition has been set at a fraction of this cost. We have worked diligently to be good financial stewards of tuition and fees. Included is the 2026-27 tuition and fee schedule.

We have started the registration process for the 2026-27 school year. **Every family** will use our FACTS Tuition Management program, which will allow you to set up a payment plan that works best for you. Please note that your family's registration will be complete when your plan is set.

Parents must enroll in FACTS Tuition Management and choose payment dates and a transaction type.

Full Tuition Payment Option: The entire tuition amount must be paid before **August 1, 2026**.

10 Month Tuition Payment Option: Tuition can be paid monthly on a schedule of your choice over the 10 months of school. A \$30 FACTS fee will be added to your invoice for this convenience.

School fees and PTO/PTA dues must be paid on or before July 1, 2026, and are considered a down payment.

Parents are expected to pay the published tuition rates for educating their children at Annunciation Catholic School, unless they receive a financial aid award through the Indiana Choice Scholarship/Voucher, the Choice Charitable Trust, or tuition assistance. For information on these programs or for instructions on applying for tuition assistance, please contact the school office. Payments are expected by the established due dates. Parents are reminded that weekly tithing by parishioners helps subsidize the education of our students and is expected and greatly appreciated.

If your family experiences a financial hardship that may alter your payments, please contact the Parish Office at (812-476-3061) immediately to make other arrangements.

Payment Options: All tuition and fees will be paid through FACTS
 School and PTO/PTA Fees: Fees must be paid on or before July 1, 2026.
 Within FACTS, they are referred to as the *Down Payment* .

OPTION 1	Full Payment Option: The entire family responsibility tuition amount must be paid before August 1, 2026. A 3% discount on the tuition will be given only to those who pay tuition in full by August 1st. (Discount is not applicable to those receiving financial funds through programs such as SGO, Tuition Assistance, or the Indiana School Choice Scholarship). Enroll in FACTS and choose Paid in full.
OPTION 2	Ten Month Payment Options: Enroll in FACTS Tuition Management and choose installment payment dates. A \$30 FACTS fee will be added to your invoice for this convenience.

Please schedule a meeting with the principal if you have questions about these options.

<p>Tuition Assistance Applications for Tuition Assistance can be made through the FACTS Financial Aid program. Contact the school office for additional information and instructions. School Tuition Assistance is available to all families in need of financial support.</p>

After School Care / Late Pick Up
After school care is available at Christ the King Campus through the YMCA. The YMCA sets their own rates for this service. Holy Spirit, a fee of \$3 per child, per day will be assessed for picking up after school between 3:15 - 3:45. Contact either campus school office for more information on these programs.

FACTS, Financial Aid, & Vouchers

FACTS is our enrollment management system. **Every family** will use FACTS to enroll their children in our school and pay their tuition and fees. **Some families** will use the FACTS Grant & Aid application to request additional aid from our parish.

Here's a quick breakdown of how FACTS will be used to enroll and/or request aid:

School Tuition Assistance:

- This aid is for those requesting additional assistance beyond the voucher. This assistance is needs-based, NOT income-based.
- To apply for financial assistance from our parish, complete the Grant & Aid application through the FACTS website **after** you have filed your 2025 taxes and have set up your payment plan. You will need your 2025 Tax Return Form 1040 and applicable schedules, as well as information about non-taxable income and other relevant financial information. If you'd like a copy of the Application Checklist to gather your documents, please call the school.
- Once your application is verified through FACTS, reviewed, and an award amount determined, you will make certain your payment plan is set up through FACTS for your remaining balance. A delay in setting up your plan may affect your payment schedule, cause your down payment of fees to be late, and result in a denied application. **Fees are due July 1, 2026, to reserve your spot in our enrollment.**

Indiana School Choice Vouchers & SGO's:

- This is a separate application from the State of Indiana and independent of additional assistance from the Parish.
- On FACTS: set up a payment plan for the remaining balance of your tuition not covered by the voucher, if applicable. You will also pay your PTO/PTA fee and other applicable fees through FACTS. (You must set up a NEW plan from last year, but can select the same options.)
- **DO NOT fill out the Grant & Aid portion** unless you need ADDITIONAL assistance beyond this state aid!
- Scholarship amounts are awarded based on your county of residence. The 2026-2027 award amounts are not yet available; we will send them as soon as they are released.
- For 2025-2026, families residing in one of the following school districts would have received the voucher amounts listed below (we expect this amount to increase slightly for 2026-2027): EVSC: \$6,822.12 Warrick: \$6,310.22

No financial assistance needed:

- Log in to your FACTS account and set up a payment plan for the 2026-2027 school year. There will be a new button marked for the new school year. You **MUST** set up a NEW plan for this year (though within the plan, you can choose the same options you had last year).

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- We have volunteers available to assist you if needed! Contact the office if you need any help understanding or completing your online application.
- Annunciation Parish will cover your FACTS aid application fee through May 31, 2026. **Starting June 1, 2026, an additional FACTS processing fee of \$40 will be charged.** Apply early to avoid the extra fee!
- Assistance is limited, so apply early!

- **ALL FAMILIES MUST SET UP A PAYMENT PLAN THROUGH FACTS.** A delay in setting up your plan may affect your payment schedule and cause your down payment of fees to be late. Fees are due **July 1, 2026**, to reserve your spot in our enrollment.

DID YOU KNOW?

Applying for school tuition assistance through FACTS costs \$40 per application. Annunciation Parish will **COVER THIS COST** for you through May 31, 2026! We are one of only a handful of parishes in the country that do not pass this fee on to families. **Families applying for tuition assistance on June 1, 2026, or later WILL BE CHARGED this \$40 application fee.** Be sure to apply early to have the parish cover your fee!

Do I need to apply for school tuition assistance through FACTS?

Please see the following chart for examples and contact us if you have any questions.

I am an active parishioner who qualifies for an Indiana School Choice Scholarship (Voucher).	No - you do not need to apply for FACTS Grant and Aid because your tuition is FULLY COVERED , or almost fully covered, by the state of Indiana! You will still need to pay your school fee / PTO fee through FACTS (no extra charge).
I am a non-parishioner who qualifies for an Indiana School Choice Scholarship (Voucher).	ONLY apply for additional assistance if your family cannot afford the remaining tuition balance. Assistance is limited, so be sure to apply early!

Remember: FACTS is NOT used to apply for an Indiana School Choice Scholarship (Voucher)! If you do not need assistance beyond the voucher, you do not need to apply for assistance through FACTS. You **WILL** still use FACTS to complete a payment plan for your remaining tuition balance, school fees, and PTO/PTA fees.

ALL FINANCIAL AID APPLICATIONS ARE CONFIDENTIAL!!

The FACTS system verifies that the information submitted is accurate based on your documentation, makes a recommended award amount, then removes the names from the applications before they are reviewed by a committee for the final award verification.

IMPORTANT: Annunciation Parish will cover the \$40 application fee for school tuition assistance applications received by May 31, 2026. **Beginning June 1, 2026, the \$40 application fee will be charged to families seeking assistance.** Be sure to apply early for maximum savings (and to have your award processed before we run out of assistance dollars)!

Still have questions? We may be having a Financial Aid Info night this spring to answer any questions and assist with applications if needed. Stay tuned for that info, coming soon! When you're ready to go, click the link or scan the QR code and head to the FACTS website to set up your payment plan and/or start your aid application (2026-2027 school year portal will open March 1.)

Definition of an “Active Parishioner family” for school tuition qualification

Annunciation Parish subsidizes tuition for all students attending Annunciation Catholic School. However, those students qualifying for parishioner family status are subsidized at a higher rate, resulting in a lower tuition for those families. Support of the school, including subsidized parishioner tuition, is a mission of our parish and has been for many years. All active and contributing members of the parish, including those without children in the school, are supporting the school through their stewardship of time, talent, and treasure. Families receiving the “Active Parishioner” family rate for tuition must also qualify as active, contributing members of the parish and meet all of the following criteria.

An Active Parishioner family is defined as:

- **A family registered in *Annunciation Parish*:** It is necessary that a family register at the parish in order to qualify for the parishioner family tuition rate for the following school year. Grandparents who are members of the parish and financially support their grandchild(ren) can qualify the child(ren) for the parishioner family tuition rate. However, they must meet with the Principal to explain these special circumstances. If you are uncertain of your registration status or if you wish to register as a member of the parish, please contact the parish office at (812) 476-3061.
- **A family actively participating in Sunday liturgy:** The Catechism of the Catholic Church states, “The Sunday celebration of the Lord's Day and his Eucharist is at the heart of the Church's life” (2177). We believe that our weekend liturgies are essential to our parish and our life of faith in God. It is our parents' responsibility to bring their children to the celebration of the Eucharist. It is for your sake that we ask you to attend Sunday Mass weekly, so that you can grow stronger in your relationship with God and with your fellow parishioners.
- **A family that demonstrates Christian principles of stewardship through the return of time, talent, and treasure to the parish:** The parish, the school, and the parishioner families are strengthened by and benefit from the involvement of parishioners in the life and mission of the parish. School families are expected to regularly participate in parish and/or school activities and ministries to both give and receive the blessings of stewardship. All of our parishioners are expected to give something to Sunday giving each week as an expression of their belonging and their desire to contribute to the fulfillment of our mission.
