Your honest feedback will guide our efforts as we develop resources, programs, and parish support that strengthen the *domestic church*, your home.

This survey will also be **anonymous**, and you will only be contacted if you request additional information and choose to share your name or email address. By sharing your perspective, you help us understand how our parishes and schools can more effectively support faith, prayer, communication, and family life.


When the survey becomes available, we encourage you to take a few minutes to complete it. Your voice is vital, and we are grateful for your willingness to help us accompany families across our Diocese.


