Dear parents and students,

We are so excited for the start of the Annunciation Youth Choir this year! Below is some important information regarding the choir (**grades 2-8**):



- Choir practice will be held in CTK church after school **every Tuesday beginning August 19, 2025.**
- Practice will begin at 2:45 (after school) and **end promptly at 3:45pm.** Please be prompt in picking up your child at the church entrance after practice. Students who are not picked up at the end of practice will be sent to Y-Care, resulting in a Y-Care fee!
- The choir will be singing at school Masses as well as several weekend Masses throughout the year. Typically, these will be at the **11am Mass on the 1st Sunday of the month.** (If there is enough interest, I would love to sing at some 9am Masses as well!) I will send out a list of dates so you can add them to your calendar. Please let me know if you are unable to attend.
- We will communicate announcements and reminders through the Remind app. **To sign up for our alerts, join our “class” through the Remind app (code: @angel-sing).** If you have trouble, contact Mrs. Creek for assistance.

My goal for the Annunciation Youth Choir is to deepen students' faith and understanding of liturgical music, as well as to develop musical and leadership skills. I also want the students to have fun and realize the value of contributing their talents in service to the Church! It is never too early to learn the blessings of stewardship! Homework Club

When and Where?

- Mondays after school 2:45 – 3:15 pm
- Tuesdays after school 2:45 – 3:15 pm
- Thursdays after school 2:45 – 3:15 pm
- First day of Homework Club will be August 25, 2025 after school
- Homework Club is held in the Computer Lab

What is Homework Club?

- Homework Club is a place for students to work on homework with the supervision of teachers on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- It will begin on Monday, Aug. 25th. At the end of September, it will be determined if Homework Club will continue after school based on the need and attendance.
- You *MUST* have homework or academics to work on when attending Homework Club. Students who consistently do not have homework to work on will be recommended to not attend.
- Students are responsible for bringing study material to work on until 3:15. They **must bring an AR book** to read if they finish all homework before dismissal.
- Only students in grades 3-8 are permitted to attend. Siblings in younger grades are not allowed to participate and will be picked up at regular dismissal time.
- When students attend a session, parents and students are responsible for making pre-arranged pick up plans in the parking lot. **STUDENTS MUST BE PICKED UP AT 3:15. Students who are picked up late 3 times, will no longer be allowed to use Homework Club.**
- This is not a mandatory or disciplinary system. All who attend are strictly on a volunteer or referral basis.
- Homework Club cannot be used in place of detention.
- Due to the program being an extension of the school day, behavior expectations are the same as during the school day and are expected to be followed.
