Logging In (Desktop/Laptop)

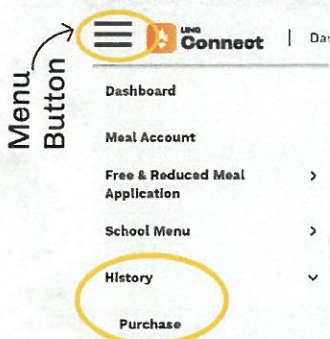
New Families

Go to: linqconnect.com and click on "Register" to create a new account. Check your email for a verification email and complete the registration process. Log into the LINQ Connect using your email and password.

Existing Users

Click on "Sign In" and use your LINQ Username and Password. Click "Sign In" again to be directed to your account.

To view your child's lunch transactions, click on the menu button, click "History" and then "Purchase."

Set Up Low Balance Reminders

Click on the menu button and then click on "Meal Account." Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the pencil in the "Payment Reminder" box. You can then set up a dollar amount to get a low balance reminder.

Payments Accepted



You can pay with Discover, MasterCard, and Visa while using LINQ. Each time a payment is made there is a minimum processing fee of \$2.60.

Cash and check payments can be sent to the school office. Please make sure the money/check is put in an envelope with the student's name and grade.

Make Recurring Payments

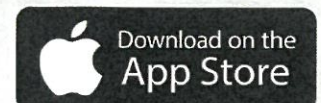
Auto Pay

- Homework Club is held in the Computer Lab

What is Homework Club?

- Homework Club is a place for students to work on homework with the supervision of teachers on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- It will begin on Monday, Aug. 24th. At the end of September, it will be determined if the Homework Club will continue after school based on the need and attendance.
- You *MUST have homework or academics to work on* when attending Homework Club. Students who consistently do not have homework to work on will be recommended to not attend.
- Students are responsible for bringing study material to work on until 3:15. They **must bring an AR book** to read if they finish all homework before dismissal.
- Only students in grades 3-8 are permitted to attend. Siblings in younger grades are not allowed to participate and will be picked up at regular dismissal time.
- When students attend a session, parents and students are responsible for making pre-arranged pick up plans in the parking lot. **STUDENTS MUST BE PICKED UP AT 3:15. Students who are picked up late 3 times, will no longer be allowed to use Homework Club.**
- This is not a mandatory or disciplinary system. All who attend are strictly on a volunteer or referral basis.
- Homework Club cannot be used in place of detention.
- Due to the program being an extension of the school day, behavior expectations are the same as during the school day and are expected to be followed.

We are so excited for the start of the Annunciation Youth Choir this year! Below is some important information regarding the choir (**grades 2-8**):



- Choir practice will be held in CTK church after school **every Tuesday** beginning **August 18, 2026**. Practice will begin at 2:45 (after school) and **end promptly at 3:45pm**. Please be prompt in picking up your child at the church entrance after practice. Students who are not picked up at the end of practice will be sent to Y-Care.
- The choir will be singing at all our school Masses throughout the year. We will also be singing at the weekend Masses twice per month. Typically, this will be the 1st Sunday of the month at 9am Mass at Holy Spirit, and the 3rd Sunday of the month at 11am at Christ the King. I will send out a list of dates for your calendar. While weekend choir is not a requirement, it is highly encouraged!
- **We will communicate announcements and reminders through Flocknotes.** To sign up for Flocknote communications, text the code **CTKCHOIR** to the number **84576** and follow the instructions in the link you receive. You may also give Mrs. Creek permission to enter your contact information on your behalf. If you have any questions, problems, or concerns, please contact Mrs. Creek for assistance!

My goal for the Annunciation Youth Choir is to deepen students' faith and understanding of liturgical music, as well as to develop musical and leadership skills. CIRCLE OF GRACE

Safe Environment Curriculum

Grade K through Grade 8

Dear Parent,

Out of concern for all God's people and in response to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, we have a curriculum for the safe environment education of children and young people supported and mandated by

Diocese/eparchies are to maintain "safe environment" programs which the diocesan/eparchial bishop deems to be in accord with Catholic moral principles. They are to be conducted cooperatively with parents, civil authorities, educators, and community organizations to provide education and training for minors, parents, ministers, educators, and others about ways to sustain and foster a safe environment for minors. Dioceses/eparchies are to make clear to clergy and members of the community the standards of conduct for clergy and other persons with regard to their conduct with minors.

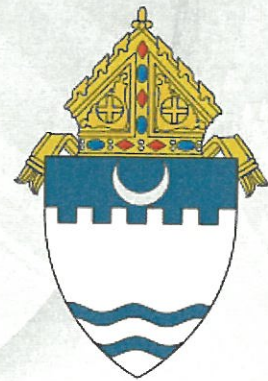
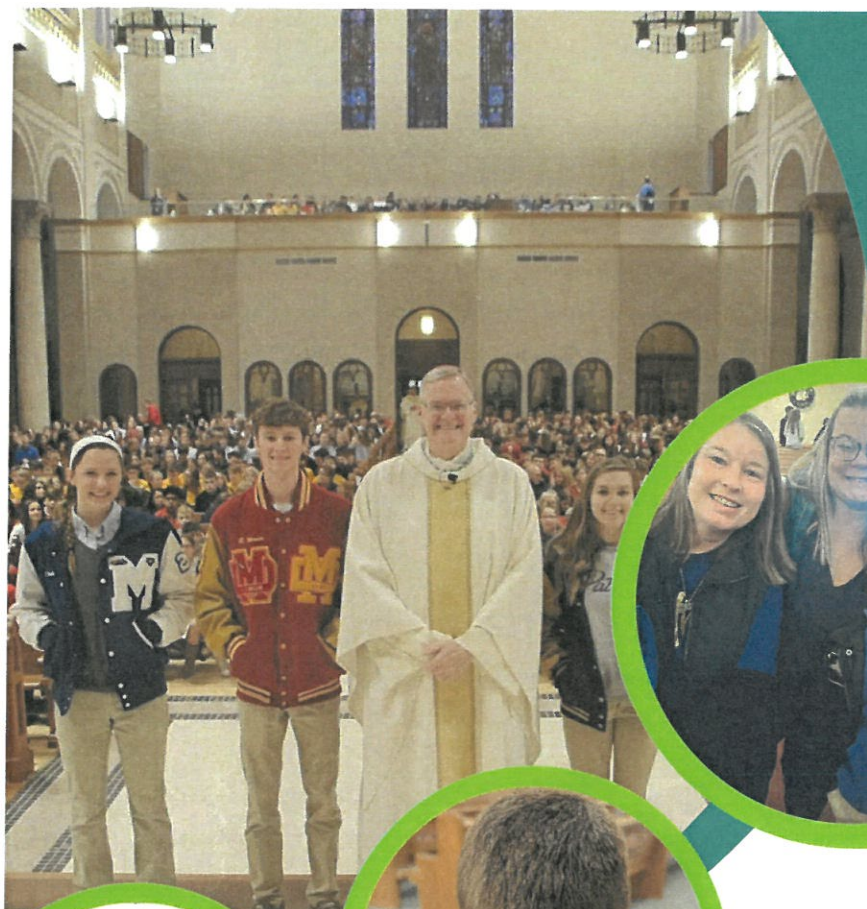
Article 12 - Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People

This curriculum is called *Circle of Grace*. It is meant to supplement and be integrated into the excellent programs and curricula for the formation of children and young people in our schools and religious education programs. *Circle of Grace* aims to equip our children and young people by arming them with essential knowledge and skills grounded in the richness of our faith. This curriculum helps children and young people to understand their own (and other's) dignity in mind, body, and spirit.

What is a Circle of Grace?

The Catholic Church teaches that God has created each of us as unique and special. Genesis 1:27 tells us that we are created "male and female in God's image" and that God saw this as "very good." In that goodness, we are meant to respect ourselves and everyone else as persons created and loved by God.

Adults assist children and young people to recognize God's love by helping them to understand that each of us lives and moves in a *Circle of Grace*. You can imagine your own *Circle of Grace* by putting your arms above your head then circle down in front of your body including side to side. This circle, front to back, holds who you are in your body and through your senses. It holds your very essence in mind, heart, soul, and sexuality.



SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

All volunteers that work with children and vulnerable adults must complete safe environment training and have a valid background check.

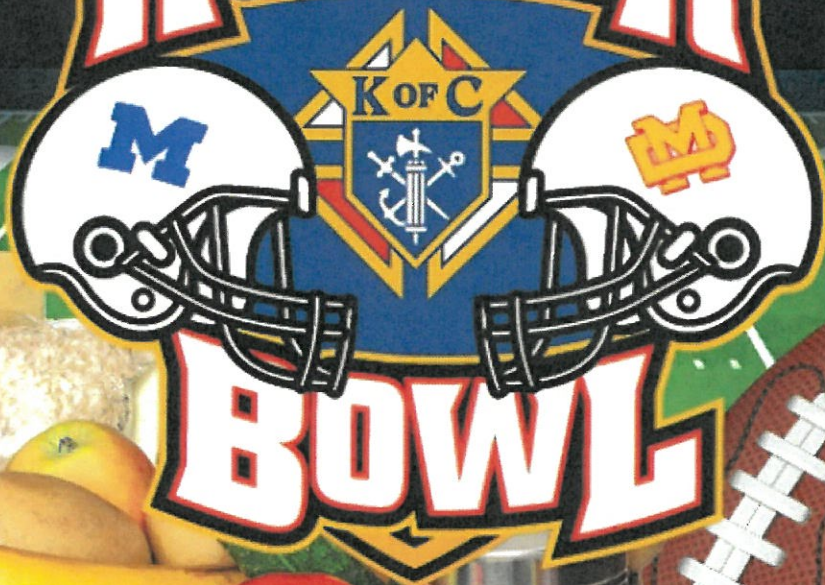
