

Shoes: Must be closed-toe. Crocs and sandals are not allowed for safety.
 If an archer is ineligible to participate due to school expectations (grades, discipline, etc.), the school's policy will be followed.
 If you register for a tournament and do not attend, No-Show fees must be paid within 1 week to remain eligible for future tournaments.
 Borrowed team bows must be returned within 2 weeks after the end of the archer's season.
