Hello Camp West Campers, Parents, Staff, and Churches,

It is mandatory that all campers have their Pastor's approval before the start of camp and that their pastor has signed their camper registration form. If this has not occurred before registration, the camper or campers will be asked to stay in the registration area along with their belongings until a member of the Camp West staff can verify that they are approved to be at Camp West by their Pastor.

DISCLAIMER

*Camp West's steering committee and staff know that some of these guidelines may or may not reflect your local assembly's standards and/or guidelines. However, we ask that all campers abide by these guidelines while attending Camp West for the duration of camp. **All guidelines are to be followed for the full duration of the camp, from the point of entering the campgrounds to camp departure.***

ATTIRE GUIDELINES: BOYS / YOUNG MEN

- Boys/young men are not permitted to wear anything that pertains to a girl or young woman.
- Boys/young men are not permitted to wear any tight-fitting clothing, including but not limited to pants, shirts, or suit coats.
- Boys/young men are not permitted to wear shorts of any kind, not even when pants are worn underneath them.
- Boys/young men are not permitted to wear their undershirts as regular shirts, and for all seniors, shirt sleeves are to be worn below the elbow.
- Boys/young men are not permitted to have any facial hair and should be clean-shaven and have a neat and clean haircut with hair off of their ears and out of their eyes.
- Boys/young men are not permitted to wear any type of jewelry or makeup.

ATTIRE GUIDELINES: GIRLS / YOUNG WOMEN

- Girls/young women are not permitted to wear anything that pertains to a boy or a young man
- Girls/young women are not permitted to wear any tight-fitting clothing, including but not limited to skirts, shirts, and dresses.
- Girls/young women are not permitted to wear their undershirts as regular shirts, and for all seniors, shirt sleeves are to be worn below the elbow
- Girls/young women are not permitted to wear pants at any time, and all skirts and dresses must be a length that covers the knees even while seated and should not have any slits that are above the knee.
- Girls/young women are not permitted to wear low-cut tops; all necklines must be no lower than two finger widths below the bottom of your neck.
- Girls/young women are prohibited from wearing makeup jewelry or painted or non-painted artificial nails.

GENERAL CAMP GUIDELINES: CHECK-IN/REGISTRATION

- Once campers have registered at the registration booth, they will no longer be allowed off campus for the duration of camp
 - **Note:** If the camper is found off campus after registration, it could result in the camper and parties involved being sent home without a refund for camp registration.
- All campers are expected to be prompt to all meals and meetings unless excused by the camp staff or head counselor.
- All campers are required to attend all classes, chapel, recreational activities, and evening services.



GENERAL CAMP GUIDELINES: DORM GUIDELINES

- For everyone's privacy, no pictures or videos should be taken inside dorms, showers, or bathrooms.
 - **Note:** Please adhere to this guideline to avoid your expulsion from camp without a refund of camp registration.
- No cell phones are permitted outside the dorm rooms without permission from your head counselor.
- There should be no watching of any kind, whether on your phone, laptop, or any other device in the dorm rooms.
 - **Note:** please use the time in your dorms to create new friendships, talk, hang out, and play games.
- Knives, guns of any kind, and anything that could be dangerous or disruptive to the camp are not permitted on campus.
 - **Note:** carrying any of these items or using them while at camp could result in expulsion from camp without a refund of camp registration.
- At no time are the boys or young men allowed in the girls' dorms. And at no time are the girls and young women allowed in the boys' dorms.
- Every camper must be responsible for his or her own bedding and personal property.
- All campers are to remain in their assigned areas of sleeping. No switching is permitted without the consent of counselors and the head counselor.
- Every camper will need their own bed, no double sleeping. This applies even to siblings. No two to any mattress or cot.

GENERAL CAMP GUIDELINES: CONDUCT GUIDELINES

- All campers should give respect to the camp facilities and property of others.
- Any camper that ruins the property of another by tampering or destroying, whether in fun or retaliation, The camper/ legal guardian will be responsible for the cost of replacing the damaged item or items and could risk being removed for the remainder of the camp without a refund of camp registration.
- Young Men and Young Ladies are not to hold hands, embrace, or wander into unlit areas.
- No fighting or foul language allowed.

GENERAL CAMP GUIDELINES: CHURCH GUIDELINES

- All campers must attend all classes, chapel, recreational activities, and evening services.
- All campers should be dressed appropriately according to the attire guidelines.
- All campers should do their best to show up in time for prayer and create an atmosphere for that service.
- When entering into service, please do so quietly so that others praying cannot be disturbed.
- When services are dismissed, please exit in a manner not disturb those who might still be praying and seeking.

IMPORTANT

All campers must have their Pastor's consent to attend camp and have received a signed camp application from their Pastor or designated signee.

By signing this form of the Camp Guidelines, you acknowledge that both yourself (as the authorized Persons) and the participant (camper), who may be the same person, agree that you have read and agreed to follow the guidelines for the full duration of camp.
