## gods at War: Who will it be—Jesus or the gods of me?

I. Identify the god of me! (Jer 2:9-13)

Wherefore I will yet plead with you, saith the Lord, and with your children's children will I plead. <sup>10</sup> For pass over the isles of Chittim, and see; and send unto Kedar, and consider diligently, and see if there be such a thing. <sup>11</sup> Hath a nation changed *their* gods, which *are* yet no gods? but my people have changed their glory for *that which* doth not profit. <sup>12</sup> Be astonished, O ye heavens, at this, and be horribly afraid, be ye very desolate, saith the Lord. <sup>13</sup> For my people have committed two evils; <sup>k</sup>they have forsaken me <sup>k</sup>the fountain of living waters, *and* hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.

- A. They took God off the throne of their hearts! (Vs13a)
- B. They chose to seek and build another source of water—another source to find life—and satisfaction, and even salvation—a broken cistern!
- II. Drink the living water instead! (Jn 4:6-14)

<sup>6</sup> Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with *his* journey, sat thus on the well: *and* it was about the sixth hour. <sup>7</sup> There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink. <sup>8</sup> (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.) <sup>9</sup> Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans. <sup>10</sup> Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he

would have given thee living water. <sup>11</sup> The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water? <sup>12</sup> Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle? <sup>13</sup> Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again: <sup>14</sup> But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither. <sup>17</sup> The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband: <sup>18</sup> For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.

But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. <sup>24</sup> God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth. <sup>25</sup> The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things. <sup>26</sup> Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am *he*.
