



Internship Summer 2026

Overview: The college intern will play a critical role in supporting our summer ministry by engaging, equipping, and empowering athletes and coaches through camps, huddles, and event planning. If you are interested in impacting youth, growing closer to God, and getting a taste for full-time ministry, then this internship is for you!

Details:

- Must be a current college student
- Must be available 20-40 hours per week between June and August (flexible).
- Must attend/work our summer camps June 15-18, June 29 – July 2, and July 16-18, and Aug 7-9
- Stipend of \$800/month given at end of summer.
 - o Intern will be responsible for raising these funds (we will train you how!)

Internship Role Description:

1. Camp. The main role of the intern will be assisting with running our summer camps. This can include being a huddle leader, assistant coach, food service helper, set up/take down, leading a group game, etc. Exact duties will depend on the need of the camp and the intern's spiritual gifts and passions.

- Must be comfortable interacting with middle/high school aged students and leading them spiritually through prayer, Bible reading, and answering questions.

2. Administrative. Intern will help with other tasks such as social media, writing emails, organizing camper documents, writing thank you cards, etc.

- Must be able to communicate with adults in a professional manner.
- Must be able to accomplish these tasks in a timely manner

3. Support Raising. A crucial part of the FCA ministry is inviting people to partner with us to allow them to see how God is working in the lives of coaches and athletes.

- Intern must be comfortable contacting family and friends via phone, email, or letter to invite them to give to their internship opportunity.

4. Spiritual Growth. Intern is expected to have a growing relationship with Jesus that includes church attendance, Bible reading, and prayer.

- Intern must meet 1v1 with a spiritual mentor throughout the internship.
