26/060.3 Whitley Village School Report

Headteacher, Russell David, attended the meeting, gave a written report that had been circulated to the committee. Points included staff development and leadership meetings. Significant changes including the introduction of a new National Curriculum, a revised Ofsted framework and reforms in Special Educational Needs. Prospective families for school visits are now preparing for the reception admissions.

26/061. Cheshire West and Chester Borough Councillors Reports

Cheshire and Warrington Combined Authority is to be formed in 2026 and for the region to elect its first Mayor in 2027.

The consultation for the Local Plan has now closed and got a good response. Any unnecessary Green Belt encroachment has been challenged. Finally, Lynn A petition has been launched calling for urgent resurfacing of the pedestrian area of Witton Street and High St in Northwich.
