ABOUT ADAC

Anti-Drug & Alcohol Crusaders, Inc. (ADAC), incorporated in 1987, is a non-profit, community-based organization. OST PROGRAM OFFERINGS

ADAC offers opportunities for K-6 students to participate in engaging out-of-school time programs.

After School

Our free after-school program takes place Monday through Friday from 3:15 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. and consists of homework time, a nutritious snack, education and prevention activities from evidence-based curricula, mentoring services, and recreational activities.

We offer extended after-care on school half-days from 12:30-6:00 p.m., including those that occur on Wednesdays once a month.

Summer Experience

ADAC hosts a four-week summer experience, which provides many opportunities for fun in a safe environment, exposure to new experiences, trips in and around the city, projects, workshops, healthy meals, and education.

PROGRAM FEATURES

Key elements of the OST program include:

- homework assistance
- healthy meals and snacks
- literacy
- STEAM
- project-based learning
- social-emotional learning
- alternative activities*
- youth workshops
- mentorship
- character- and self-esteem building
- prevention of negative behaviors
- evidence-based prevention curricula
- field trips and outings

*Alternative activities are used as a method to prevent youth's engaging in negative behaviors through providing healthy, positive outlets and experiences for youth.
