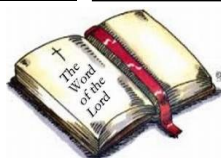

A BIG THANK YOU FROM THE ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CONFERENCE

Our conference assisted many needy people in our parish from December 19, 2024 to December 18, 2025. During that period we received 162 phone calls requesting assistance and we contacted each one. Through the generosity of you, our parishioners, we provided **\$26,435.43** in assistance to a total of **41 families** for utilities, food, transportation, housing assistance, and other needs. **Number of Adults helped: 64, number of Children helped: 39.** Once per quarter we sponsored and served meals for the hungry at Hope's Corner. Members of the parish donated gift cards to our Christmas Giving Tree program: 44 children in 14 different families received gifts and money for their Christmas dinners. With the assistance of St. Joseph Parish and School, and 200 parishioners who prepared meals, served our guests, or donated funds, we were able to serve 505 Thanksgiving Dinners during our Thanksgiving Dinner for the Hungry. The event was a huge success and we had many happy individuals and families. Thank you all for your support throughout this year so we could help others. We are truly grateful for your generosity and we look forward to continuing to work together in the new year, growing in faith and service as one community.

El evento fue un gran éxito y trajo alegría a muchas personas y familias. Gracias a todos por su apoyo durante este año, que nos permitió ayudar a los demás.
