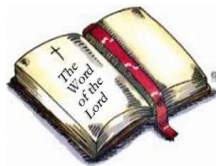

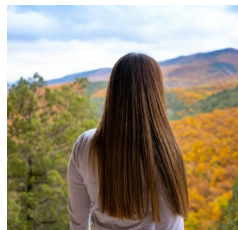

ORDINARY TIME IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Ordinary Time is one of the main seasons of the Catholic Liturgical Year. It does not refer to “common time” as something trivial, but rather to “ordered” or “counted,” hence the word ordinary. It is a time to grow in the life of faith, deepen in the teachings of Jesus, and live out his message in everyday life.

When it is celebrated—Ordinary Time is divided into two parts:

1. After the Christmas season and before Lent.
2. After Pentecost and before Advent.

It occupies most of the liturgical year, approximately 33 to 34 weeks.

Liturgical color—During Ordinary Time, **green** is used, symbolizing hope, growth, and Christian life. On certain special solemnities, the color may change, but green is predominant.

Preparation for other seasons—It helps the faithful integrate spirituality into daily life before important seasons like Lent. The focus is on living the faith in everyday life, not just during special celebrations.

EL TIEMPO ORDINARIO EN LA IGLESIA CATÓLICA

El Tiempo Ordinario es una de las principales temporadas del Año Litúrgico de la Iglesia Católica. No se refiere a “tiempo común” como algo trivial, sino a “ordenado” o “contado”, de ahí la palabra ordinario. Es un tiempo para crecer en la vida de fe, profundizar en la enseñanza de Jesús y vivir su mensaje en la vida cotidiana.

Cuándo se celebra—El Tiempo Ordinario se divide en dos partes:

1. Después del Tiempo de Navidad y antes de la Cuaresma.
2. Después de Pentecostés y antes del Adviento.

Ocupa la mayor parte del año litúrgico, aproximadamente 33 a 34 semanas.

*Color litúrgico—Durante el Tiempo Ordinario se usa el **verde**, que simboliza esperanza, crecimiento y vida cristiana.*

En algunas solemnidades especiales puede cambiar el color, pero el verde es predominante.

Preparación para otras temporadas—Ayuda a los fieles a integrar la espiritualidad en la vida diaria antes de tiempos fuertes como Cuaresma. Se enfatiza vivir la fe en la vida cotidiana, no solo en festividades especiales.
