Catechetical Corner

Sacrosanctum Concilium

The Liturgy, the Center of Christian Life

- ♦ The liturgy is the work of Christ and of the Church. In it, the work of our redemption is accomplished (SC 2, 7). "Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in their midst" (Mt 18:20).
- ♦ The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. The whole life of the Church flows from and is directed toward the liturgy (SC 10). "The bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world" (Jn 6:51).
- ♦ Full, conscious, and active participation of the faithful. Not merely external, but interior and spiritual (SC 14). "Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God" (Rom 12:1).
- ♦ The real presence of Christ in the liturgy. Christ is present in the priest, the Word, the sacraments, and the assembled community (SC 7). "This is my Body... this is my Blood" (Mt 26:26-28). "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing" (Lk 4:21).
- ♦ The liturgy leads to a transformed and missionary life. What is celebrated is lived and proclaimed (SC 9). "Go and make disciples" (Mt 28:19).

Subsequent Magisterium:

The Catechism teaches that the liturgy is an "action of Christ and of the Church" and a "foretaste of the heavenly liturgy" (CCC 1069-1071).

Saint John Paul II reminded us that liturgical reform must be lived in fidelity and reverence (*Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, 2003).

For Reflection:

Does the liturgy I celebrate lead me to a life offered to God and to the service of others?

La liturgia, centro de la vida Cristiana

- ♦ La liturgia es obra de Cristo y de la Iglesia. En ella se realiza la obra de nuestra redención (SC 2, 7). "Donde dos o tres se reúnen en mi nombre, allí estoy yo" (Mt 18,20).
- ♦ La Eucaristía es fuente y culmen de la vida cristiana. Toda la vida de la Iglesia brota y converge en la liturgia (SC 10). "El pan que yo daré es mi carne para la vida del mundo" (Jn 6,51).
- ♦ Participación plena, consciente y activa de los fieles. No solo exterior, sino interior y espiritual (SC 14). "Ofrezcan sus cuerpos como sacrificio vivo, santo y agradable a Dios" (Rm 12,1).
- ♦ Presencia real de Cristo en la liturgia. Cristo está presente en el sacerdote, la Palabra, los sacramentos y la asamblea (SC 7). "Esto es mi Cuerpo... esta es mi Sangre" (Mt 26,26-28). "Hoy se cumple esta Escritura" (Lc 4,21).
- ♦ La liturgia conduce a una vida transformada y misionera. Lo celebrado se vive y se anuncia (SC 9). "Vayan y hagan discípulos" (Mt 28,19).

Magisterio posterior:

El Catecismo enseña que la liturgia es "acción de Cristo y de la Iglesia" y "anticipo de la liturgia celestial" (CIC 1069-1071). San Juan Pablo II recordó que la reforma litúrgica debe vivirse en fidelidad y reverencia (*Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, 2003).
