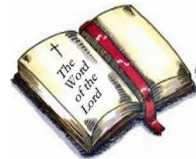

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

In the gospel for Divine Mercy Sunday (Year A), the disciples are hiding in fear after Jesus' crucifixion. They are scared and uncertain about their future. When Jesus appears to them, His first words are "Peace be with you." This is more than a greeting. It is a message of comfort and reassurance. Jesus offers them peace to calm their fears and remind them that He is with them. Jesus then shows them His wounds. These wounds are proof of His suffering, but they are also a sign of forgiveness. Despite being abandoned by His closest friends during His crucifixion, Jesus does not hold their fear or doubt against them. He forgives them and gives them peace. This shows that His mercy is greater than their failures.

Divine Mercy Sunday reminds us that Jesus offers us the same peace and forgiveness. No matter what mistakes we have made, Jesus is ready to forgive us. He invites us to come to Him with our fears, doubts, and sins. We don't need to be perfect to receive His mercy. We are also called to share this peace and forgiveness with others. Just as Jesus forgave His disciples, we are asked to forgive those who have hurt us. By doing this, we bring His peace into our relationships and our world. DOMINGO DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

En el evangelio del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia (Año A), los discípulos están escondidos por miedo después de la crucifixión de Jesús. Tienen miedo e incertidumbre sobre su futuro. Cuando Jesús se les aparece, sus primeras palabras son: "La paz esté con ustedes". Esto es más que un simple saludo. Es un mensaje de consuelo y de seguridad. Jesús les ofrece su paz para calmar sus temores y recordarles que Él está con ellos.

Luego, Jesús les muestra sus heridas. Estas heridas son prueba de su sufrimiento, pero también son un signo de perdón. A pesar de haber sido abandonado por sus amigos más cercanos durante su crucifixión, Jesús no les reprocha su miedo ni su duda. Él los perdona y les da su paz. Esto demuestra que su misericordia es más grande que sus fallas.

El Domingo de la Divina Misericordia nos recuerda que Jesús nos ofrece la misma paz y el mismo perdón. No importa qué errores hayamos cometido, Jesús está listo para perdonarnos. Nos invita a acercarnos a Él con nuestros miedos, dudas y pecados. No necesitamos ser perfectos para recibir su misericordia. Nos llama a compartir esta paz y este perdón con los demás. Así como Jesús perdonó a sus discípulos, nosotros estamos llamados a perdonar a quienes nos han hecho daño. Al hacerlo, llevamos su paz a nuestras relaciones y a nuestro mundo y nos desafía a ser instrumentos de paz y de misericordia.
