**GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY**

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is called Good Shepherd Sunday. On this day, we hear readings that remind us how Jesus leads, protects, and cares for His people. The image of the shepherd is one of the most comforting pictures in the Bible. It shows the closeness and love between God and His People.

On this Sunday, the Church reflects on Jesus as the Good Shepherd who knows His sheep and leads them to life. The image of the gate helps explain how Jesus protects and guides, not through fear, but through care and trust.

The readings show Jesus as the one who leads and protects His people. Many turn to Him, are baptized, and begin a new life. He calls His followers to trust Him and receive the life He gives. "I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly." (John 10:10).

### WHAT IS LITURGICAL RENEWAL?

You may be hearing the words “liturgical renewal” for the first time. Here is what it means in simple terms: over the next two years, our diocese will reflect on each part of the Mass as part of our greater Pastoral Plan journey of spiritual renewal. Each season spotlights one part of the Mass, diving into its meaning, its beauty, and how we can participate more fully as a community. Rest assured, liturgical renewal is not about criticizing how anyone has been worshipping. It is an invitation to spiritual renewal—to experience the Mass more deeply and participate more fully in the Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic life. The Second Vatican Council called all of us to participate fully, consciously, and actively in the liturgy — bringing our whole selves to Mass: our hearts, our voices, our attention, and our lives. This renewal is our response to that call, as the Body of Christ gathered to worship as one family.

### ¿QUÉ ES LA RENOVACIÓN LITÚRGICA?

*Es posible que escuches por primera vez las palabras “renovación litúrgica”. En términos sencillos, esto significa lo siguiente: durante los próximos dos años, nuestra diócesis reflexionará sobre cada parte de la Misa como parte de nuestro Plan Pastoral de renovación espiritual. Cada tiempo litúrgico pondrá el enfoque en una parte de la Misa, profundizando en su significado, su belleza y en cómo podemos participar más plenamente como comunidad. Es importante aclarar que la renovación litúrgica no es una crítica a la forma en que hemos estado participando en la adoración. Más bien, es una invitación a la renovación espiritual: a vivir la Misa más profundamente y a participar de manera más plena en la Eucaristía, fuente y culmen de nuestra vida católica. El Concilio Vaticano II nos llamó a todos a participar de manera plena, consciente y activa en la liturgia, llevando a la Misa todo nuestro ser: nuestro corazón, nuestra voz, nuestra atención y nuestra vida. Esta renovación es nuestra respuesta a ese llamado, como Cuerpo de Cristo reunido para adorar como una sola familia.*
