**The Penitential Act** (bulletin 6/14/26)

**The Liturgy of the Word** — Following the Penitential Act comes the Liturgy of the Word, in which God speaks to His people through Sacred Scripture. The readings, the Responsorial Psalm, the Gospel Acclamation, the Gospel, the Homily, the Creed—when prescribed—and the Universal Prayer (Prayer of the Faithful) make up this part of the Mass. The Church teaches that Christ is present in His Word, since it is He Himself who speaks when the Scriptures are read in the Church (CCC 1088; GIRM 29).
