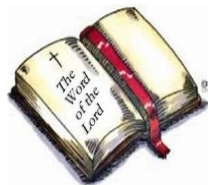

THE HOLY MASS STEP BY STEP... (CONTINUED)

The Eucharistic Liturgy begins with the presentation of the gifts. The bread and wine are brought to the altar to become the Body and Blood of Christ. The collection may also be presented as a sign of the community's offering and charity. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) teaches that the altar is the center of the entire Eucharistic Liturgy because on it the sacrifice of Christ is sacramentally made present (GIRM 73). At this moment, the faithful are also called to offer their lives, their work, their sufferings, and their joys to God.

Main sources used: the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the General Instruction of the Roman Missal.

También se puede presentar la colecta, signo de la entrega y caridad de la comunidad. La Instrucción General del Misal Romano (IGMR) enseña que el altar es el centro de toda la Liturgia Eucarística, porque sobre él se realiza sacramentalmente el sacrificio de Cristo (IGMR 73). En este momento, los fieles están llamados a ofrecer también su vida, trabajos, sufrimientos y alegrías a Dios.*
