THE HOLY MASS STEP BY STEP... (CONTINUED)

The Eucharistic Prayer is the heart of the Mass. In it, the Church gives thanks to the Father, invokes the Holy Spirit upon the bread and wine, recalls Jesus' words at the Last Supper, and offers to the Father the sacrifice of Christ. The Catechism teaches that the Eucharist is the memorial of Christ's Passover. It is not merely a remembrance, but the sacramental making present of His one sacrifice on the Cross (CCC 1362-1367). At the consecration, through the words of Christ and the action of the Holy Spirit, the bread and wine are truly transformed into the Body and Blood of the Lord. The Church calls this mystery the Real Presence, because Christ is present truly, really, and substantially in the Eucharist (CCC 1374). For this reason, before the Blessed Sacrament, the faithful respond with faith, adoration, silence, reverence, and love.

La Plegaria Eucarística—es el corazón de la Misa. En ella, la Iglesia da gracias al Padre, invoca al Espíritu Santo sobre el pan y el vino, recuerda las palabras de Jesús en la Última Cena y ofrece al Padre el sacrificio de Cristo. El Catecismo enseña que la Eucaristía es el memorial de la Pascua de Cristo: no es un simple recuerdo, sino la actualización sacramental de su único sacrificio en la Cruz (CEC 1362-1367). En la consagración, por las palabras de Cristo y la acción del Espíritu Santo, el pan y el vino se convierten verdaderamente en el Cuerpo y la Sangre del Señor. La Iglesia llama a este misterio "presencia real", porque Cristo está presente verdadera, real y substancialmente en la Eucaristía (CEC 1374). Por eso, ante el Santísimo Sacramento, los fieles responden con fe, adoración, silencio, reverencia y amor.

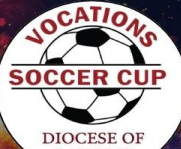
