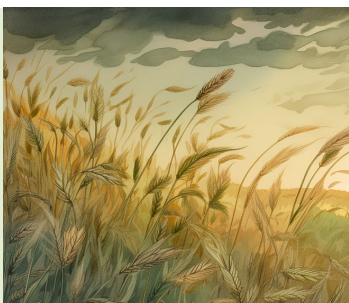

**The Eucharistic Prayer** (bulletin 7/12/26)

**The Communion Rite** follows the Eucharistic Prayer. We pray the Our Father, ask for peace, participate in the breaking of the bread, and come forward to receive Christ in Holy Communion. Communion is not merely a symbol of unity; it is receiving Christ himself, who gives himself as food for eternal life. The Catechism teaches that the Eucharist increases our union with Christ, separates us from sin, and strengthens charity (CCC 1391-1395). When receiving Holy Communion, the faithful must approach with faith, respect, and interior preparation. Saint Paul reminds us that each person must examine himself before eating the bread and drinking from the cup (cf. 1 Cor 11:28). Therefore, the Church teaches that anyone conscious of grave sin must first receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before receiving Communion (CCC 1385). Communion, when received worthily, transforms the heart and impels us to live as true disciples of Christ.

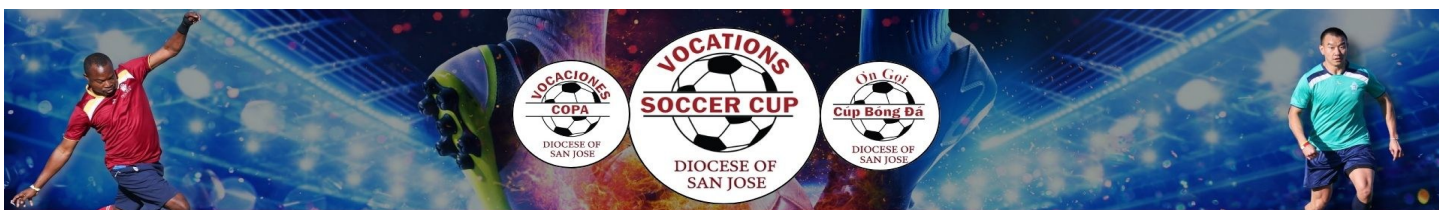

**El Rito de la Comunión**—viene después de la Plegaria Eucarística. Rezamos el Padre Nuestro, pedimos la paz, participamos en la fracción del Pan y nos acercamos a recibir a Cristo en la Sagrada Comunión. La Comunión no es solamente un símbolo de unidad: es recibir al mismo Cristo, que se entrega como alimento de vida eterna. El Catecismo enseña que la Eucaristía aumenta nuestra unión con Cristo, nos separa del pecado y fortalece la caridad (CEC 1391-1395). Al recibir la Sagrada Comunión, el fiel debe acercarse con fe, respeto y preparación interior. San Pablo nos recuerda que cada uno debe examinarse antes de comer del pan y beber del cáliz (cf. 1 Cor 11,28). Por eso, la Iglesia enseña que quien tiene conciencia de pecado grave debe recibir primero el sacramento de la Reconciliación antes de comulgar (CEC 1385). La Comunión bien recibida transforma el corazón y nos impulsa a vivir como verdaderos discípulos de Cristo.
