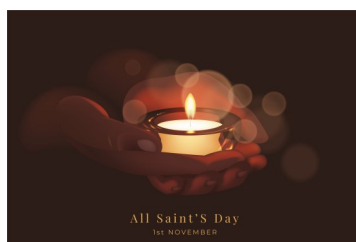

## Catechetical Corner

The formation of every servant of the Catholic Church, whether new or experienced, is essential to serving with fidelity, love, and truth. The desire to help is not enough: it is necessary to allow oneself to be molded by Christ and to know deeply the faith that is proclaimed.

And the Catechism reminds us: "The lay faithful have the duty and the right to acquire a deeper knowledge of the faith." (CCC #900) To be formed is to grow in communion with the Church and with the capacity to bear witness to the Gospel with joy.

Saint Augustine tells us: "Greatness does not lie with the one who commands, but with the one who serves with love." Christ himself "did not come to be served, but to serve" (Mt 20:28).

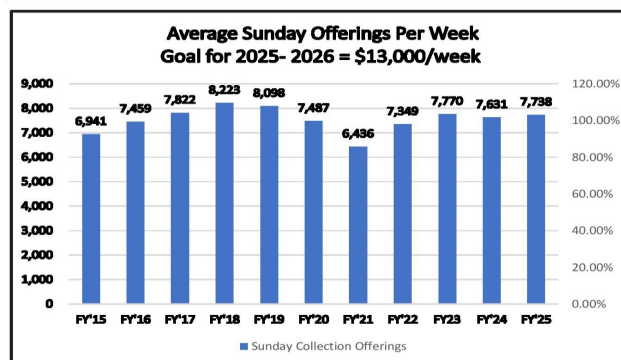
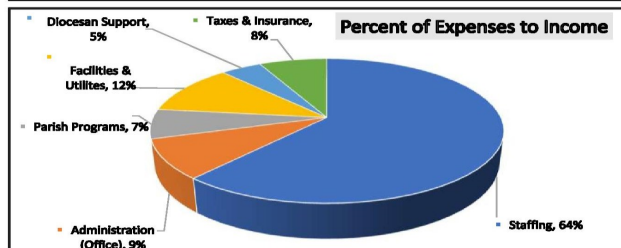
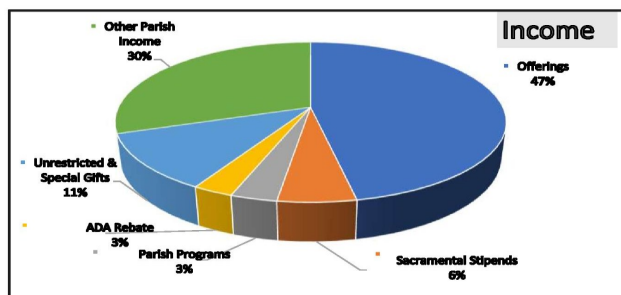
