Catechetical Corner

DEEPENING YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

The cardinal virtues are the fundamental human virtues upon which all other moral virtues are based. They are called "cardinal" because the word comes from the Latin *cardo*, meaning "hinge": all other virtues "turn" on them.

Justice

- ♦ Definition: It is the virtue that gives each person what is due to them, respecting the rights of God and of others.
- ♦ Fruit: It generates right relationships with others and with God.
- ♦ Bible verse: "Learn to do good; seek justice." (Isaiah 1:17)

"Justice is inseparable from mercy, for both are the fruit of divine love." – St. Catherine of Siena.

St. Catherine of Siena emphasizes that justice and mercy must go together to fully reflect Christian virtue.

The Cardinal Virtues help us remain steadfast in the faith, especially in times of weariness, persecution, or discouragement.

PROFUNDIZANDO TU RELACIÓN CON DIOS

Las cuatro virtudes cardinales son las virtudes humanas fundamentales sobre las que se apoyan todas las demás virtudes morales. Son llamadas "cardinales" porque la palabra proviene del latín *cardo*, que significa "gozne" o "bisagra": en ellas "giran" las demás virtudes.

Justicia

- ♦ Definición: Es la virtud que da a cada uno lo que le corresponde, respetando los derechos de Dios y del prójimo.
- ♦ Fruto: Genera relaciones rectas con los demás y con Dios.
- ♦ Cita bíblica: "Aprended a hacer el bien: buscad la justicia." (Isaías 1,17)

«La justicia es inseparable de la misericordia, pues ambas son fruto del amor divino» - Santa Catalina de Siena.

Santa Catalina de Siena resalta que justicia y misericordia deben ir juntas para reflejar plenamente la virtud cristiana.

Las Virtudes Cardinales nos permiten mantenernos firmes en la fe, especialmente en el cansancio, la persecución o el desánimo.
