CHARTER SCHOOL POLICIES & GUIDELINES

2026-2027

REGISTRATION FEE:

This fee pays **secondary** insurance for your child to be out on our floor during class time and open workout. Our goal is to provide the best we can for your child and we feel our choice of insurance companies reflects this. Insurance is purchased for one year for your child, so we must charge this fee annually. Should you drop classes for a month (or more) and then return within 12 months of paying your original registration fee, you will not be required to pay a registration fee until the quarter containing your original 1 year anniversary date. This fee is **non-refundable** and **non-transferable**.

PURCHASE ORDERS (PO):

- Purchase orders must be received and approved before your child will be allowed in class.
- It is the parent's responsibility to make sure Precision has an accurate PO at all times.
- If a PO runs out and we do not have a purchase order to continue, you will be required to pay for your child's class OR your child will be dropped from class until we receive a valid PO or payment. Purchase order totals may not exceed 1 month and must reflect the accurate month and class being billed.
- Once we've received a PO for a particular class, we cannot change the class mid-month. You may choose to drop out of the class & only be charged for the days attended, but we cannot apply funds from the PO to another class. A new PO must be submitted/approved to change your class program or day. We will invoice for all PO's at the end of each month, once all classes have been completed.
- The payment deadline for all families is the 27th of each month. To remain enrolled in the Charter School program, purchase orders for the upcoming month must be submitted to our office **before** the 27th. If a PO is not received by the deadline, you will be transitioned out of the charter program, and **your card will be charged for the upcoming month's tuition until the PO is submitted.**

CALCULATING CLASS TOTALS

All programs are billed at a flat monthly tuition rate. Your monthly tuition remains the same regardless of the number of class meetings in a given month. While some months may have only three class meetings due to holidays or scheduling, others will have five class meetings. Over the course of the year, these variations balance out, allowing us to offer consistent monthly pricing.

Students who begin classes after the start of the month will receive prorated tuition based on their start date. Purchase orders must reflect the correct monthly tuition amount listed on the Pricing Page. **Purchase orders submitted with incorrect tuition amounts will be returned for correction before they can be accepted and processed.**

PAYMENTS/CREDITS/REFUNDS:

Payment/PO is due at the time of sign-up. If you do not have a valid PO the day prior to your child's start date, you will be required to pay out of pocket to secure their spot. Once a PO is received, you will be refunded. All families are required to have a valid payment method on file at all times. Families must have a card on file at the time of sign-up in order to be able to reserve their spot without payment. Failure to do so will result in your child being dropped from the program.

If Precision is open during a day your charter school is closed, you are still responsible for payment of that day. For example: minor holidays or spring break... if we are open, there is still class. Your child's place in class is still being held & you will be charged for this day. If your charter school will not include this in a PO you are responsible for the payment. We will invoice for all PO's once the month has ended. If your charter school is unable to pay a PO for any reason, Precision will contact the parent directly for payment.

CLASS ENROLLMENT:

Precision Gymnastics wants your child to have a safe, fun and educational experience while you are with us. In order to accomplish this, we have to be able to regulate class size. If you find that you are going to have to drop classes either permanently or temporarily, you must notify the front desk in advance. Failure to do so will result in you being responsible for tuition until we are notified that your child is dropping class. Keeping up-to-date records is difficult without knowing what your intentions are. Help us help you by maintaining class size integrity.

_____ I understand a new PO must be submitted/approved to change class program or class day.

_____ I understand that I am responsible for payment for any class dates not covered by my charter, including non-school days

_____ I understand that I must have a valid payment method stored on my account (parent portal) at all times, beginning with the moment of enrollment.

_____ I understand that I will be responsible for class tuition until I notify the front desk of my plan to drop class.

_____ I understand it is my responsibility to request purchase orders from my Charter School.

_____ I understand it is my responsibility to check that purchase orders have been submitted to Precision Gymnastics.

_____ I understand that if I do not have a valid purchase order (PO) on file, my card will be charged on the 27th of each month for the following month's payment. This will occur as I transition from the charter school program to a self-paying customer, and I will be subject to the standard payment policies.
