The Town of Pine Level held a Mayor and Council Special Called Council Meeting on Tuesday, April 9, 2024, in a meeting room of Spirit Walk Ministries.

PLEDGE OF ALLIGANCE

INVOCATION Mayor Bigley gave the invocation.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Bigley called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL Mayor Bigley called roll. Present were Councilmembers Gray, Hickman, Moore and Worcester. Also, present was Town Clerk Theresa L. Cook and Town Attorneys Nancy Kirby and Nikki Ivey.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Mayor Bigley asked the Council to review the meeting agenda. He called for a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made by Councilmember Worcester and seconded by Councilmember Gray.

NEW BUSINESS

Pertaining to the Town's tax ordinances, Mayor Bigley presented an overview of the information received from the Alabama Department of Revenue. There was a motion made and seconded to table the amended ordinances.

Attorney Ivey provided that Town is not required to that two reading of these amended ordinances is not required.

Attorney Ivey provided information from researching the annexation of the Deavers' properties. These properties are indeed contiguous due to an Attorney General's Opinion. The Central Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission had previously advised Mayor Bigley and Town Clerk Cook that the properties were not contiguous.

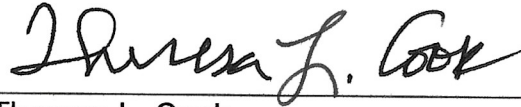
There was a discussion pertaining to the title of "Clerk" and "Treasurer" in the ordinances. Further research will follow and be presented to the Council.

There was no public discussion.

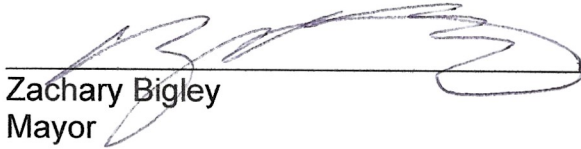
ADJOURNMENT There being no further business, Mayor Bigley moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Gray and passed unanimously by those present.
