3. ALCOHOL TAX

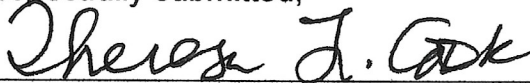

4. GENERAL DISCUSSIONS

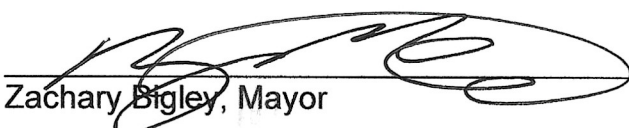
