PLEDGE OF ALLIGANCE

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Bigley called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL Mayor Bigley called roll. Present were Councilmembers Bixler, Gray, Moore, Hickman, and Worcester. Also, present was Town Clerk Theresa Cook and Town Attorney Nancy Kirby.


Mayor Bigley shared information on the Autauga County Probate Office billings for the incorporation and annexation.
